Message from the Our Pastor – Fourth Sunday of Easter

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

The Fourth Sunday of Easter is traditionally known as Good Shepherd Sunday, and the Church invites us to linger over one of the most intimate and powerful images Jesus uses to describe himself. In the Gospel (John 10:1–10), Jesus speaks not only as the shepherd, but also as the gate through which the sheep enter. This double image opens a rich reflection on trust, belonging, and the promise of abundant life.

Jesus begins with a contrast: there are those who enter the sheepfold properly—through the gate—and those who try to climb in another way. The sheep, he says, recognize the voice of the true shepherd. They follow because they know him. This is not mere familiarity; it is a relationship built on trust. The sheep do not follow a stranger because they do not recognize that voice. This image speaks directly to the spiritual life. In a world filled with competing voices—cultural pressures, personal anxieties, false promises of fulfillment—the Christian is called to discern the voice of Christ. His voice is not coercive or manipulative. It is steady, personal, and life-giving. It calls each person by name.

Jesus then deepens the image: “I am the gate.” This might seem like a shift, but it actually completes the picture. The gate is the place of passage, of safety, of belonging. Through Christ, we enter into communion with God. Through him, we find protection and nourishment. To pass through this gate is to accept a relationship that shapes our entire existence.

The second reading from Acts reminds us what this looks like in practice. Peter proclaims boldly that salvation comes through Jesus Christ. The response of the people—“What are we to do?”—is answered with a call to repentance and baptism. Entering through the gate is not abstract; it is a concrete turning of one’s life toward Christ.

The responsorial psalm beautifully echoes this theme: “The Lord is my shepherd; there is nothing I shall want.” This familiar line is not sentimental. It is a declaration of radical trust. To say the Lord is my shepherd is to acknowledge dependence, guidance, and care—even through “dark valleys.”

Finally, Jesus makes a striking promise: “I came so that they might have life and have it more abundantly.” This is the heart of the Gospel. Christianity is not merely about avoiding sin or following rules; it is about receiving a fullness of life that only Christ can give. This abundance is not measured in material success but in peace, purpose, and communion with God. On this Good Shepherd Sunday, the invitation is simple but profound: Whose voice am I following? Do I recognize the voice of Christ in prayer, in Scripture, in the teachings of the Church? Am I willing to enter fully through the gate—to trust him not partially, but completely? Christ is not distant. He calls, he leads, he protects, and he gives life. The challenge is not whether he speaks, but whether we are listening.

We were blessed with 18 Baptisms on Easter Vigil and 29 on last Sunday and these are the participants of our Sacramental preparation classes. This is a good sign of human desire for fullness of life that Jesus brings to us by his Life, Death and Resurrection. Let us follow him and we will share in his gift of eternal life.

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas:

El Cuarto Domingo de Pascua es tradicionalmente conocido como el Domingo del Buen Pastor, y la Iglesia nos invita a detenernos en una de las imágenes más íntimas y poderosas que Jesús utiliza para describirse a sí mismo. En el Evangelio (Juan 10, 1-10), Jesús habla no solo como el pastor, sino también como la puerta por la que entran las ovejas. Esta doble imagen abre una rica reflexión sobre la confianza, la pertenencia y la promesa de una vida en abundancia.

Jesús comienza con un contraste: hay quienes entran en el redil correctamente—por la puerta—y quienes intentan entrar por otro camino. Las ovejas, dice, reconocen la voz del verdadero pastor. Lo siguen porque lo conocen. No se trata de una simple familiaridad; es una relación construida sobre la confianza. Las ovejas no siguen a un extraño porque no reconocen esa voz. Esta imagen habla directamente a la vida espiritual. En un mundo lleno de voces que compiten—presiones culturales, ansiedades personales, falsas promesas de realización—el cristiano está llamado a discernir la voz de Cristo. Su voz no es coercitiva ni manipuladora. Es constante, personal y da vida. Llama a cada persona por su nombre.

Luego Jesús profundiza la imagen: «Yo soy la puerta». Esto puede parecer un cambio, pero en realidad completa el cuadro. La puerta es el lugar de paso, de seguridad, de pertenencia. Por Cristo entramos en comunión con Dios. Por medio de Él encontramos protección y alimento. Pasar por esta puerta es aceptar una relación que da forma a toda nuestra existencia.

La segunda lectura de los Hechos de los Apóstoles nos recuerda cómo se ve esto en la práctica. Pedro proclama con valentía que la salvación viene por medio de Jesucristo. La respuesta del pueblo—«¿Qué tenemos que hacer?»—se responde con un llamado al arrepentimiento y al bautismo. Entrar por la puerta no es algo abstracto; es un giro concreto de la vida hacia Cristo. El salmo responsorial refleja bellamente este tema: «El Señor es mi pastor, nada me falta». Esta línea tan conocida no es sentimental. Es una declaración de confianza radical. Decir que el Señor es mi pastor es reconocer la dependencia, la guía y el cuidado—incluso a través de «valles oscuros».

Jesús nos hace una promesa impactante: «Yo he venido para que tengan vida y la tengan en abundancia». Este es el corazón del Evangelio. El cristianismo no se trata simplemente de evitar el pecado o seguir reglas; se trata de recibir una plenitud de vida que solo Cristo puede dar. Esta abundancia no se mide en éxito material, sino en paz, propósito y comunión con Dios.

En este Domingo del Buen Pastor, la invitación es simple pero profunda: ¿A quién estoy siguiendo? ¿Reconozco la voz de Cristo en la oración, en la Escritura, en las enseñanzas de la Iglesia? ¿Estoy dispuesto a entrar plenamente por la puerta—a confiar en Él no parcialmente, sino completamente? Cristo no está distante. Él llama, guía, protege y da vida. El desafío no es si Él habla, sino si nosotros estamos escuchando.

Fuimos bendecidos con 18 bautismos en la Vigilia Pascual y 29 el domingo pasado, y estos son participantes de nuestras clases de preparación sacramental. Esto es una buena señal del deseo humano de la plenitud de vida que Jesús nos ofrece por su Vida, Muerte y Resurrección. Sigámoslo y compartiremos su don de vida eterna.

Quatrième dimanche de Pâques (4/26/26)

Frères et sœurs,

Les lectures de ce dimanche nous présentent une image très belle et très concrète : celle de Jésus comme le Bon Pasteur.

Dans l'Évangile selon saint Jean, Jésus dit : « Je suis la porte des brebis. » Cela peut nous surprendre. Il ne dit pas seulement qu'il guide, mais qu'il est lui-même le passage. Cela signifie que c'est par lui que nous entrons dans la vraie vie, dans la sécurité, dans la communion avec Dieu.

Dans la première lecture, Pierre s'adresse à la foule avec force : « Convertissez-vous. » Et beaucoup accueillent sa parole. Ils reconnaissent qu'ils ont besoin de changer de direction, de passer par cette "porte" qu'est le Christ.

Et dans la deuxième lecture, saint Pierre nous rappelle que Jésus est le pasteur qui prend soin de nous jusqu'au bout. Il a souffert pour nous, il a porté nos péchés, afin que nous revenions à lui, le « berger et gardien de nos âmes ».

Alors, aujourd'hui, une question simple peut nous habiter :

Est-ce que je reconnais vraiment la voix du Bon Pasteur dans ma vie ?

Car il y a beaucoup de voix autour de nous — des voix qui promettent le bonheur, le succès, la sécurité — mais toutes ne conduisent pas à la vie. Jésus, lui, ne trompe pas. Il appelle chacun par son nom, il connaît notre cœur, et il nous guide avec amour.

Suivre le Christ, ce n'est pas seulement croire en lui, c'est apprendre à écouter sa voix chaque jour : dans la prière, dans l'Évangile, dans les autres.

Et il nous fait une promesse extraordinaire : « Je suis venu pour que les brebis aient la vie, et qu'elles l'aient en abondance. »

Demandons aujourd'hui la grâce de reconnaître sa voix, de lui faire confiance, et de marcher à sa suite avec foi.

Amen.

Pilgrimage to Fatima, Lourdes, & Northern Spain

Our Lady of Garabandal Cantabria, Spain Quick Navigation: Story

Our Lady of Garabandal is an apparition of Our Lady to four girls from a rural village named San Sebastián de Garabandal in Spain. This apparition began in the year 1961 and lasted until 1965, with Our Lady taking on the appearance of Our Lady of Mount Carmel.

This apparition has not been officially

approved by the Church. This apparition shares many similarities with the apparitions of La Salette, Lourdes, Fatima, and Medjugorje, namely involving Our Lady sharing secrets with the children she appears to. Additionally, much like those other apparitions, the purpose of this visitation was to call for a conversion of heart.

In this particular apparition, two messages were shared with the children: one from St. Michael, and the other from Our Lady. The first message was given in 1961 by Saint Michael on behalf of Our Lady and called for sacrifice, penance, and frequent Communion to avoid an impending chastisement. The second message, given in 1965 by Our Lady personally, said that the previous message was not complied with, that the cup that was once filling was now spilling out. This message warned that many clergy are following the road to perdition and are taking many souls with them. Additionally, less and less importance was being given to the Holy Eucharist. Even so, the message said that it isn't yet too late to ask for God's forgiveness.

In addition to these two messages, the visionaries foretell of a warning, a miracle, and a chastisement if people do not correct their ways. The warning is described as a worldwide stopping of time where people would see their souls as God sees them – a mini-judgement. Many people call this foretold phenomenon the Illumination of Conscience. A year after the warning, a miracle will leave a permanent sign in Garabandal which can be seen and photographed, but not touched. The description of this miracle is astonishingly similar to the sign foretold by the Medjugorje visionaries in their own village. The final chastisement has been described as a great fire descending from heaven. According to the visionaries, however, the punishment can be avoided depending on how people react to the warning and the miracle.

It is interesting to note, after the death of Pope John XXIII in 1963, Our Lady spoke to one of the visionaries, Cochita, and told her that there are only three popes left until the end of times. The same year, in 1963, Our Lady mentioned that there will be a pope who will govern the church for a very short time who is not counted as one of the three Popes. Counting the popes since Pope John XXIII, Pope Paul VI would have been the first pope mentioned. Pope John Paul I, who reigned for 33 days, would have been the pope that is not counted. Pope John Paul II would have been the second pope, and Pope Benedict XVI, who died in 2022, would have been the third. Therefore, According to Cochita's vision, the end of times will begin during Pope Francis's reign. It is important to note that the "end of times" doesn't mean the "end of the world", nor will the papacy cease to exist, but rather we will enter into a new period in the Church's history.

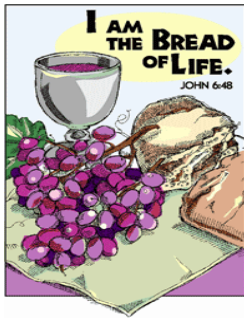
