Dear Sisters and Brothers,

Pentecost is often called the birthday of the Church, but it is more than a celebration of a beginning. It is a reminder that the Church does not live by its own strength. The Church lives and breathes through the gift of the Holy Spirit.

In the first reading from Acts, the disciples are gathered together, uncertain and hidden away behind closed doors. Suddenly, wind fills the house and tongues of fire rest upon them. What follows is remarkable: people from many different nations hear the disciples speaking and each understands in his or her own language. The miracle is not merely about speech. It is about unity. The Holy Spirit does not erase differences; He brings people together through them.

St. Paul continues this message in his letter to the Corinthians. He reminds us that there are many gifts but one Spirit, many forms of service but one Lord. Not every person is called to the same work, yet every gift is valuable. Some teach, some serve quietly, some lead, some encourage, some pray faithfully behind the scenes. The Spirit distributes gifts not for personal recognition but for the building up of the Body of Christ.

In the Gospel, Jesus appears to the disciples who are hiding behind locked doors. Into their fear He speaks simple words: “Peace be with you.” Then He breathes on them and says, “Receive the Holy Spirit.” The same Spirit that transformed frightened disciples into courageous witnesses is still given to us today.

Pentecost invites each of us to ask an important question: What gift has the Spirit placed within me? We sometimes assume that only extraordinary talents matter. Yet the Church depends just as much on ordinary faithfulness: a kind word, a helping hand, a willingness to listen, a quiet prayer for someone in need.

The Holy Spirit does not simply comfort us; He sends us. The disciples did not remain in the upper room after Pentecost. They went out into the world with courage and joy. As we celebrate this feast, may we pray for hearts open to the Spirit’s guidance and for the courage to use our gifts in service to God and one another, to build the Church of today. Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of the faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love.

Estimados Hermanos y Hermanas,

A menudo se llama a Pentecostés el cumpleaños de la Iglesia, pero es mucho más que la celebración de un comienzo. Es el recordatorio de que la Iglesia no vive por sus propias fuerzas. La Iglesia vive y respira a través del don del Espíritu Santo. En la primera lectura de los Hechos de los Apóstoles, los discípulos están reunidos, inseguros y escondidos detrás de puertas cerradas. De repente, un viento llena la casa y lenguas como de fuego se posan sobre ellos. Lo que sigue es extraordinario: personas de muchas naciones diferentes escuchan hablar a los discípulos y cada una entiende en su propia lengua. El milagro no se trata simplemente del habla; se trata de la unidad. El Espíritu Santo no elimina las diferencias; Él reúne a las personas a través de ellas.

San Pablo continúa este mensaje en su carta a los Corintios. Nos recuerda que hay muchos dones, pero un solo Espíritu; muchas formas de servicio, pero un solo Señor. No todas las personas son llamadas a la misma misión, pero cada don es valioso. Algunos enseñan, algunos sirven silenciosamente, algunos guían, algunos animan y otros oran fielmente detrás de escena. El Espíritu distribuye los dones no para el reconocimiento personal, sino para la edificación del Cuerpo de Cristo.

En el Evangelio, Jesús se aparece a los discípulos que están escondidos detrás de puertas cerradas. En medio de su miedo les dirige unas palabras sencillas: “La paz esté con ustedes”. Luego sopla sobre ellos y les dice: “Reciban el Espíritu Santo”. El mismo Espíritu que transformó a discípulos atemorizados en testigos valientes sigue siendo dado a nosotros hoy.

Pentecostés invita a cada uno de nosotros a hacernos una pregunta importante: ¿Qué don ha puesto el Espíritu dentro de mí? A veces suponemos que solo los talentos extraordinarios son importantes. Sin embargo, la Iglesia depende igualmente de la fidelidad cotidiana: una palabra amable, una mano amiga, la disposición para escuchar, una oración silenciosa por alguien que necesita ayuda.

El Espíritu Santo no solo nos consuela; también nos envía. Los discípulos no permanecieron en el aposento alto después de Pentecostés. Salieron al mundo con valentía y alegría. Mientras celebramos esta fiesta, pidamos corazones abiertos a la guía del Espíritu y el valor para usar nuestros dones al servicio de Dios y de los demás para construir la Iglesia de hoy. Ven, Espíritu Santo, llena los corazones de tus fieles y enciende en ellos el fuego de tu amor.

¡Que Dios bendiga siempre a todos!

Aujourd'hui, demandons au Saint-Esprit :

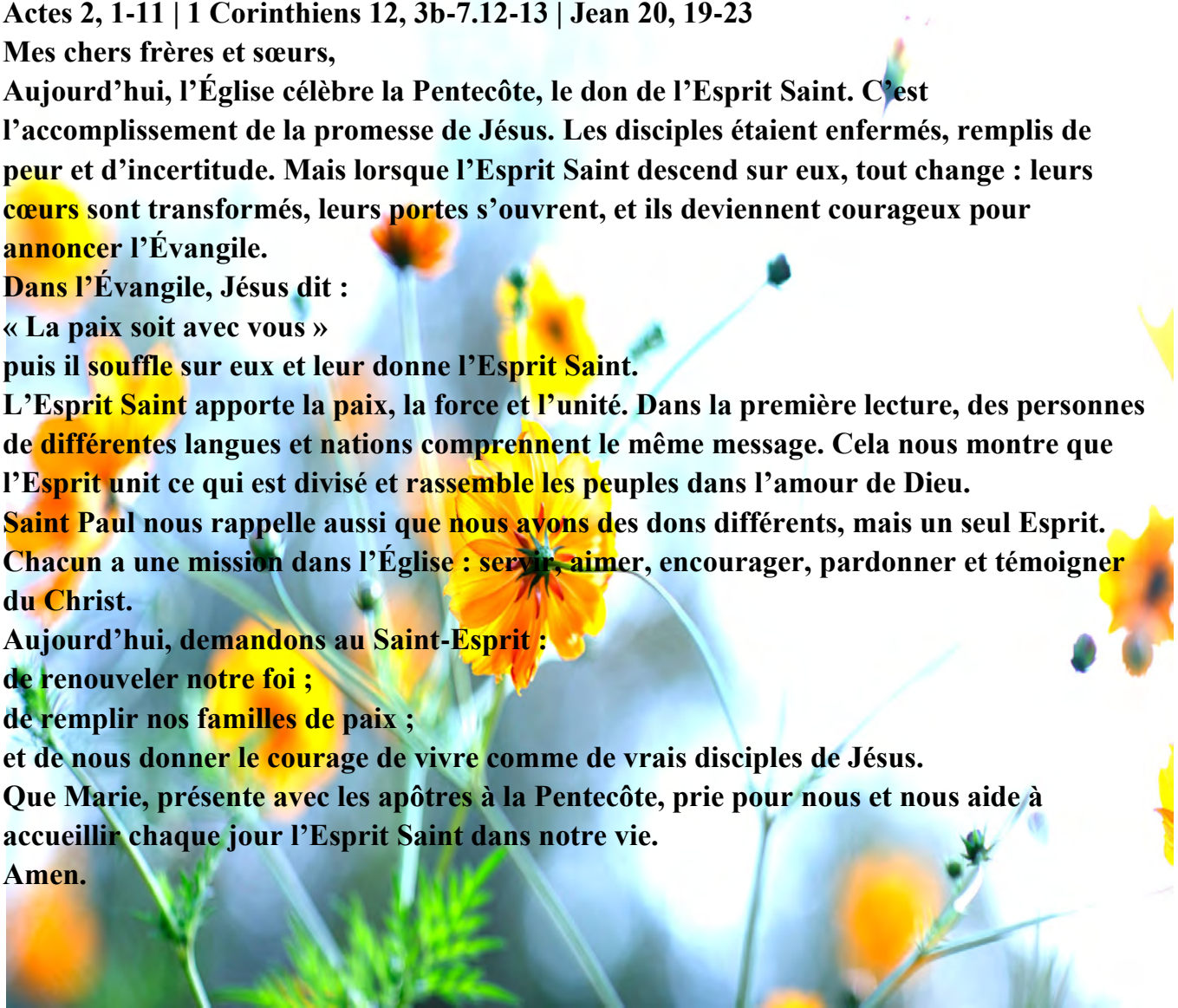
de renouveler notre foi ;

**PILGRIMAGE TO FATIMA,
LOURDES AND SPAIN
SEPT. 28TH – OCT. 9TH 2026
WITH FR. STAN**



Day 3 Wed. Sept. 30th Lisbon-Santarem-Fatima

In the morning, we will departure towards Fatima. On the way we will stop in the old city of Santarem. In Santarem we will visit and attend Mass at the Church of St. Stephen, which holds the oldest (13th century) recorded Eucharistic Miracle in Portugal. The Miracle occurred when a woman yearned to change the ways of her unfaithful husband and consulted a sorceress. The sorceress agreed that she would cure the husband's infidelity in exchange for a consecrated Host. The woman committed the sacrilege, but when she exited the church, the Host began to bleed. It bled so much that her fellow parishioners thought she had cut her hand. The woman ran home and hid the bleeding Host in a trunk. When her husband arrived home, the wife told him what she had done, and later that night there was a light emanating from the trunk. She and her husband began to kneel before the trunk. The following morning, the husband and wife brought the Host to the parish priest. It was then moved to the Church of St. Stephen where another miracle occurred; the miraculous Host was originally put in a wax container, however, when a priest opened the tabernacle to view the Host, the container was found broken, and the Host was found enclosed in a crystal pyx. Continuation of the journey to Fatima. In the afternoon we will start the visit of the most important places related to the apparitions located in the surroundings of Fatima: Parish Church of Fatima, the Cemetery of Fatima (Where we will find the tomb where Saint Francesco and Saint Jacinta were buried after they passed away) and Aljustrel (The hamlet of the three children). In Aljustrel we will visit the houses where the three children lived and also the well where the Angel of Peace appeared in Summer 1916 (second apparition of the Angel). Dinner in the hotel. After dinner we will be able to gather with the rest of the pilgrims in Fatima at the Chapel of the Apparitions, where Our Blessed Mother appeared, to pray the Rosary and to participate in the candlelight procession. Overnight in Fatima.
