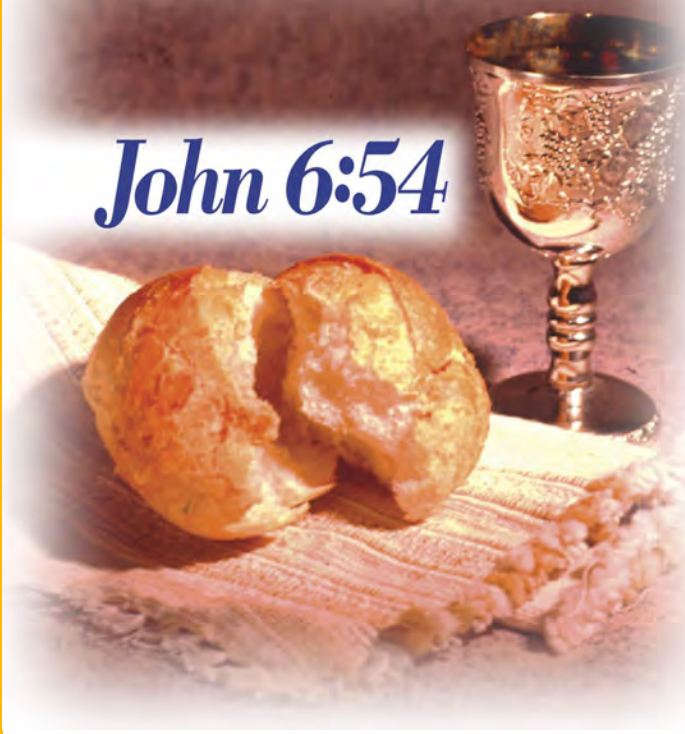

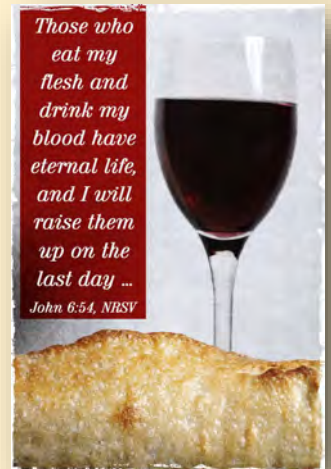

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, traditionally known as Corpus Christi. This feast invites us to reflect with gratitude and wonder on the greatest gift Jesus left to His Church: the Holy Eucharist. On the night before He died, Jesus took bread and wine and transformed them into His Body and Blood, giving them to His disciples and commanding them, "Do this in remembrance of me." Through these simple yet profound actions, Christ established the sacrament that would remain at the heart of Christian life for all generations.



The Eucharist is much more than a symbol or a memorial meal. Catholics believe that Jesus is truly present—Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity—in the consecrated bread and wine. Every Mass is an encounter with the living Christ, who continues to nourish His people with the same love He showed on Calvary. This feast reminds us that God has always desired to feed His people. In the desert, He provided manna for the Israelites. In the fullness of time, He gave us something infinitely greater: His own Son as the Bread of Life. Jesus tells us that whoever eats this bread will live forever because the Eucharist unites us to His saving death and resurrection.

The Eucharist is also a sacrament of unity. As we receive the one Bread, we become one Body in Christ. The Lord gathers people from every background and circumstance and forms us into a community of faith, hope, and charity. Our participation at Mass should inspire us to carry Christ's love into our homes, workplaces, schools, and neighborhoods.

This feast also brings to mind the witness of Blessed Carlo Acutis, the young Italian who had a deep love for the Eucharist and called it his "highway to heaven." Carlo used his gifts in technology to create a website documenting Eucharistic miracles from around the world, helping others discover the reality of Christ's presence in the Blessed Sacrament. His example reminds us that devotion to the Eucharist is not only for saints of the distant past but is a path to holiness for people of every age, especially the young.

Corpus Christi challenges us not only to believe in Christ's presence on the altar but also to recognize His presence in one another, especially in those who are poor, lonely, suffering, or forgotten. The Eucharist strengthens us to become what we receive—the Body of Christ in the world. As we celebrate this beautiful feast, may our hearts be renewed in gratitude for the gift of the Eucharist. Inspired by the faith of Blessed Carlo Acutis, may we approach the altar with reverence and joy, deepen our devotion to the Blessed Sacrament, and allow Christ's presence to transform our lives each day.

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas,

Este fin de semana celebramos la Solemnidad del Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo, tradicionalmente conocida como Corpus Christi. Esta fiesta nos invita a reflexionar con gratitud y asombro sobre el mayor regalo que Jesús dejó a su Iglesia: la Sagrada Eucaristía. La noche antes de morir, Jesús tomó pan y vino y los transformó en su Cuerpo y Sangre, entregándolos a sus discípulos y mandándoles: «Hagan esto en memoria mía». A través de estas acciones sencillas pero profundas, Cristo instituyó el sacramento que permanecería en el centro de la vida cristiana para todas las generaciones.



La Eucaristía es mucho más que un símbolo o una comida conmemorativa. Los católicos creemos que Jesús está verdaderamente presente —Cuerpo, Sangre, Alma y Divinidad— en el pan y el vino consagrados. Cada Misa es un encuentro con Cristo vivo, que continúa alimentando a su pueblo con el mismo amor que mostró en el Calvario. Esta fiesta nos recuerda que Dios siempre ha querido alimentar a su pueblo. En el desierto, proporcionó el maná a los israelitas. En la plenitud de los tiempos, nos dio algo infinitamente mayor: a su propio Hijo como el Pan de Vida. Jesús nos dice que quien coma de este pan vivirá para siempre, porque la Eucaristía nos une a su muerte y resurrección salvadoras.

La Eucaristía es también un sacramento de unidad. Al recibir el único Pan, nos convertimos en un solo Cuerpo en Cristo. El Señor reúne a personas de todos los orígenes y circunstancias y nos forma como una comunidad de fe, esperanza y caridad. Nuestra participación en la Misa debe inspirarnos a llevar el amor de Cristo a nuestros hogares, lugares de trabajo, escuelas y vecindarios.

Esta fiesta también nos recuerda el testimonio del Santo Carlo Acutis, el joven italiano que tuvo un profundo amor por la Eucaristía y la llamó su «autopista hacia el cielo». Carlo utilizó sus talentos en la tecnología para crear un sitio web que documentaba milagros eucarísticos de todo el mundo, ayudando a otros a descubrir la realidad de la presencia de Cristo en el Santísimo Sacramento. Su ejemplo nos recuerda que la devoción a la Eucaristía no es solo para los santos de tiempos pasados, sino que es un camino de santidad para personas de todas las edades, especialmente para los jóvenes.

Corpus Christi nos desafía no solo a creer en la presencia de Cristo en el altar, sino también a reconocer su presencia en los demás, especialmente en los pobres, los solitarios, los que sufren y los olvidados. La Eucaristía nos fortalece para convertirnos en aquello que recibimos: el Cuerpo de Cristo en el mundo.

Al celebrar esta hermosa fiesta, que nuestros corazones se renueven en gratitud por el don de la Eucaristía. Inspirados por la fe del Santo Carlo Acutis, acerquémonos al altar con reverencia y alegría, profundicemos nuestra devoción al Santísimo Sacramento y permitamos que la presencia de Cristo transforme nuestras vidas cada día.

La Solennité du Très Saint Corps et Sang du Christ (Fête-Dieu)
(06/07/26)

Jn 6:51-58

Frères et sœurs,

Aujourd'hui, l'Église célèbre le grand mystère de l'Eucharistie, le Corps et le Sang du Christ. Les lectures nous invitent à reconnaître que Dieu nourrit son peuple et lui donne la vie.

Dans la première lecture, Moïse rappelle au peuple d'Israël comment Dieu l'a conduit dans le désert et l'a nourri avec la manne. Cette nourriture était un signe de la sollicitude de Dieu. Mais elle annonçait une nourriture bien plus grande.

Dans l'Évangile, Jésus déclare : « Je suis le pain vivant descendu du ciel. » Il ne donne pas seulement quelque chose ; il se donne lui-même. Dans l'Eucharistie, nous recevons le Christ vivant, qui nourrit notre foi, fortifie notre espérance et nous apprend à aimer comme lui.

Saint Paul nous rappelle que le pain que nous partageons fait de nous « un seul corps ». L'Eucharistie n'est pas seulement une rencontre personnelle avec Jésus ; elle construit aussi notre unité. En communiant au même Pain, nous devenons davantage frères et sœurs les uns des autres.

En cette fête du Corps et du Sang du Christ, demandons la grâce de recevoir l'Eucharistie avec foi, gratitude et amour. Que cette nourriture divine transforme notre vie afin que nous devenions, à notre tour, pain partagé pour nos frères et sœurs, spécialement les plus pauvres et les plus seuls.

Amen.

Day 4: Thursday, Oct. 01, Fatima

We rise and have breakfast. Today will surely be a memorable experience, as you pray and meditate upon one of Our Blessed Mother's apparitions' sites. Our Lady appeared to three shepherd children: Lucia (age 10), Jacinta (age 7), and Francisco (age 9). These apparitions occurred monthly from May until October of 1917. Historically, as the entire world was in true turmoil, Our Lady's most prominent message during this time was to pray for world peace. View the monument that commemorates the Sacred Heart of Jesus, in the square. Due to Our Lady's consistency in Her messages to pray the Rosary, this Basilica also features fifteen altars, dedicated to the fifteen mysteries of the Rosary. While in the Basilica, you will be able to feel, through the Love of Our Lord and Lady, the many graces that were received here. Visit the Museum with the exhibition : Fatima: Light and Peace. Continue with a visit to the Holy Trinity Basilica. After free time for lunch, we will experience Christ's unconditional love by participating in the Stations of the Cross along the Via Sacra. ***(This exciting day continues in next week's bulletin)***
