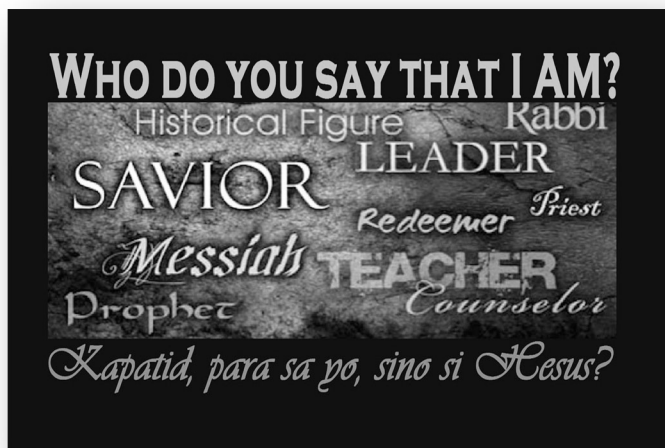
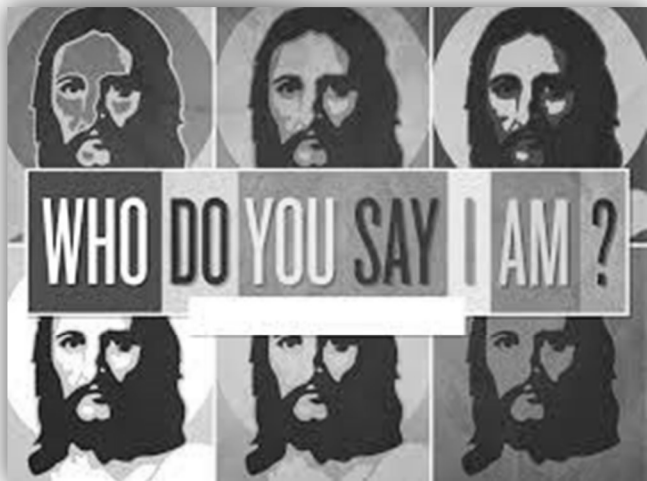

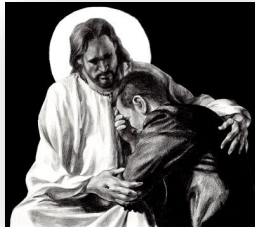

SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION ST. ANNE'S PARISH

SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

Baptism: For children under 5, please contact the Parish Office (273-8113) for an appointment to speak with a Priest or Deacon at least several weeks before the Baptism. For older children, contact the Office of Family Faith Formation (231-7344).

First Holy Communion: Children usually begin Religious Education studies in the First Grade and are prepared for Communion in the Second Grade. Call the Family Faith Formation Office (231-7344) to register your child the summer before the school year begins.

Confirmation: This Sacrament is currently celebrated in the Eighth Grade after 2 years of preparation. Please call the Religious Education Office (231-7344) for more information.

SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

Sacrament of the Sick: Call the Parish Office at any time to arrange for the Anointing of the Sick either at home or in the hospital.

Reconciliation: The Sacrament is celebrated every Saturday from 4:00 - 4:45 PM in the Church or by appointment.

SACRAMENTS OF VOCATION

Marriage: Congratulations! Couples planning to marry should make an appointment with a Priest or Deacon at least eight (8) months in advance of the wedding to allow time for adequate preparation.

Holy Orders: Is God calling you? Call a Priest or Deacon to discern a possible vocation to the Priesthood, Diaconate or the Religious life.

DEVOTIONS

Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament: Each Thursday from 12:30 PM until 5:15 PM. First Friday from 5:30 PM until 7:00 PM. Rosary after the 12:00 daily Mass.

Miraculous Medal Novena: Monday after the 12:00 Mass and First Saturday from 8:15 - 9:00 AM.

R.C.I.A.

From the Pastor

Dear Sisters and Brothers !

Hopefully this weekend it is going to be nice weather, so that everyone can enjoy Father's Day. We want to wish all Fathers many blessings, joy and satisfaction coming from your children and grandchildren. May Our Lord reward all your sacrifices of yours and your wife's and Mothers that you make for your children. May He show you his kindness and mercy, may He console you and heal your hurts and disappointments that life may have given you through your children. Please remember that your children are as well God's children, so when you pray don't say:

Dear God, make my children pleasing to me. Please pray : Dear God, make my children pleasing to You, since they are not only mine, but above all, yours. You have given them to me, and I am just a helper, and You are the true Father of us all. Let your will be done in the lives of my children. Give me the grace to see it and to seek it for them and for myself.

God bless you all in that gift of parenthood, all Fathers and Mothers !!!!

As in regard to God's children, as I mentioned before for the summer time we will not cancel the 5:00 pm Masses on Sundays, but we will give you the opportunity to use the Sundays in new way. You may go to the beach in the mornings and spent the day there and enjoy the sunshine and the water around The Island, than for the afternoon you come to Mass and dinner with your family and friends.

Because of the summer requests for Baptisms, we will celebrate them at the 5:00 pm Sunday Masses as well, so to give people an opportunity to be at Mass, and to have their baptism guests for celebration on Sunday, as Saturday it is still a working day for many. So please be prepared to have baptisms on those Sunday Summer Masses, with bilingual touch to it. I ask priests that we use it as a great opportunity to teach us about the privilege of the grace of Baptism, and of the connection of it to Holy Mass, that continues to nourish this divine life in all of the baptized.

In the Gospel of today Jesus asks question: "Who do you say that I am ? "

Who is Jesus for me ??? Is He the Savior that I am awaiting for every day??? The One that I lean on for everything ??? The One that I love and trust in good times and in bad ??? Or who is He for you ??? Each of us has to answer that question in a personal way, speaking from heart to heart.

Then Jesus says those difficult words: "If anyone wishes to come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me." What it means ??? Aren't we supposed to be happy with Jesus ??? Doesn't He want us to be happy in this life ??? Why we have to carry crosses in this life ??? How many crosses should we carry before we say it is enough ??? Is there any way that we could avoid all the crosses ??? Which of the crosses should we take and which we should refuse???

So many questions and they all seem very personal, that no one can answer it for us. Let us dialogue about it with Jesus himself, and I'm sure He will inspire his answer to be heard in the depths of our hearts.

As for the strange crosses, I'm going to ask Alex to put that special cross made of car parts to be put on the wall so that it can continue to challenge us with its looks and meaning that are hidden in the relationship of the metal with the soul of one that looks at it. I'm still thinking if it should be in the basement, or somewhere on the church floor to be accessible to all, not only the basement visitors.

As for the things around the church, we are trying to improve things. I thank for your support in prayer, in donations and in action. Choose your way of support, as we need them all and I thank you for your generosity with time and treasure.

Just one simple think, look at the floor as we are in the process of cleaning it, all done by volunteers. When you look up, by the statue of the Blessed Mother you will see a broken window glass that we replaced last year. It is a special hardened glass that costed us around \$ 560 and last year we had three of them broken. It never ends. We will continue to maintain our church and buildings as they are our home, where we pray, learn, work and live.

God bless you and all your loved ones wherever they are !!!
