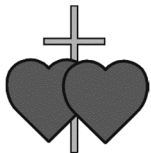

SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

Baptism: For children under 5, please contact the Parish Office (273-8113) for an appointment to speak with a Priest or Deacon at least several weeks before the Baptism. For older children, contact the Office of Family Faith Formation (231-7344).

First Holy Communion: Children usually begin Religious Education studies in the First Grade and are prepared for Communion in the Second Grade. Call the Family Faith Formation Office (231-7344) to register your child the summer before the school year begins.

Confirmation: This Sacrament is currently celebrated in the Eighth Grade after 2 years of preparation. Please call the Religious Education Office (231-7344) for more information.

SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

Sacrament of the Sick: Call the Parish Office at any time to arrange for the Anointing of the Sick either at home or in the hospital.

Reconciliation: The Sacrament is celebrated every week-day at 5:00p.m. also Saturday from 4:00 - 4:45 PM in the Church and at 8:30a.m. and 10:30 a.m. on Sundays or by appointment by calling the business office 631-273-8113.

SACRAMENTS OF VOCATION

Marriage: Congratulations! Couples planning to marry should make an appointment with a Priest or Deacon at least eight (8) months in advance of the wedding to allow time for adequate preparation.

Holy Orders: Is God calling you? Call a Priest or Deacon to discern a possible vocation to the Priesthood, Diaconate or the Religious life.

A Message from your Pastor

Dear Friends,

Have a blessed Labor Day with your loved ones. Enjoy the sunshine and the water, the quiet of solitude or the busyness of the barbecue that you may choose to have with your family and friends. Let the children and youth enjoy the last games of the summer, than all get back to studying or working mood as the fall approaches. May God bless all workers and providers for their family and for themselves ! May God who is the first provider, inspire all employers to treat their workers with respect and reward them for their work justly.

In the Gospel Jesus says today that; " if anyone comes to me without hating his father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters, and even his own life, he cannot be my disciple." Does Jesus really mean it ??? To hate our closest persons in life??? Surly not, but he is trying to remind us that we truly love each other if we bring them to God, if we lead them to heaven where our eternal family is and will be if we all strive to get there. It is only a reminder for us that it is God who saves us and we need to remember this in all we do. This is why the rest of this Sunday Gospel reminds us about calculating on how to get to heaven ??? How to make it ??? How to live our lives that it would qualify us for heaven, to see God and to contemplate his glory and to be part of it for all eternity ???

Today we have a reminder of it in the next Saint that we are receiving from the Church in the person of Saint Teresa of Calcutta called Mother Teresa of Calcutta. A Saint who wanted to be just " a pencil in the hand of God", a pencil that God would use to write and make his designs. Mother Teresa used to say that if she would not decide to help the first person, she would never help many others after. We need to make our choice about it, a choice to serve, a choice to see people and situations of need and to respond to them. We want to be committed to that choice and only than it becomes our way of life, a way of service to God who is hiding himself in the person that is in need of any kind; material, spiritual or psychological. Mother Teresa found people in need everywhere, She used to say that we may find Calcutta everywhere, even in New York there are poor, homeless, hungry, lost and lonely people. It is Christ himself hidden in those persons, and longing to be loved and cared for.

Where did She find strength to go and serve others daily? When you go to the chapel of the Missionaries of Charity Sisters, Brothers or Fathers, you will find on the wall of the chapel a crucifix with the words " I THIRST " on the side of the cross. It is a cry of Jesus uttered from the cross before his death, meaning that Jesus is thirsty, but as Christ himself revealed it to Mother Teresa, he is not thirsty for water or other drink, but he is thirsting for his love to be returned by us, he is thirsting for our love. If we want to satisfy his thirst we need to love Christ, specially in the persons that are " on the peripheries of life " as Pope Francis would say. Do you know that Christ is THIRSTING for your love ???

This Sunday I will be in Rome for Mother Teresa's canonization. I was invited to go with the staff of Ave Maria University in Florida. Mr James Towey, who is the President of the University was asked 28 years ago by Mother Teresa of Calcutta, to help me, this polish seminarian, Stan Wadowski. to help me get a USA visa in Paris, so as to be able to join the Missionaries of Charity Fathers in the Bronx. Now, Mr. Towey says, "that he feels that now Blessed Mother Teresa is asking him to take me to Rome, so with all that, I said yes and so I am blessed to go and be part of this great celebration and I will represent all of St. Anne's Parish at the Canonization. Pray for me please, as I promise to pray for you all in Rome and everywhere !!!

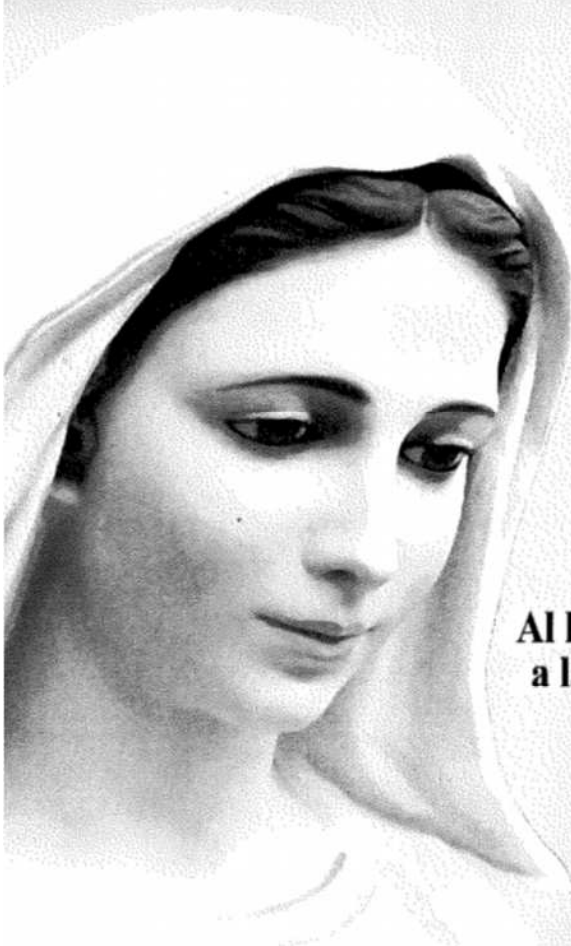
