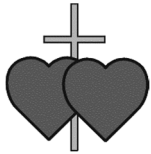

SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

Baptism: For children under 5, please contact the Parish Office (273-8113) for an appointment to speak with a Priest or Deacon at least several weeks before the Baptism. For older children, contact the Office of Family Faith Formation (231-7344).

First Holy Communion: Children usually begin Religious Education studies in the First Grade and are prepared for Communion in the Second Grade. Call the Family Faith Formation Office (231-7344) to register your child the summer before the school year begins.

Confirmation: This Sacrament is currently celebrated in the Eighth Grade after 2 years of preparation. Please call the Religious Education Office (231-7344) for more information.

SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

Sacrament of the Sick: Call the Parish Office at any time to arrange for the Anointing of the Sick either at home or in the hospital.

Reconciliation: The Sacrament is celebrated every week-day at 5:00p.m. also Saturday from 4:00 - 4:45 PM in the Church and at 8:30a.m. and 10:30 a.m. on Sundays or by appointment by calling the business office 631-273-8113.

SACRAMENTS OF VOCATION

Marriage: Congratulations! Couples planning to marry should make an appointment with a Priest or Deacon at least eight (8) months in advance of the wedding to allow time for adequate preparation.

Holy Orders: Is God calling you? Call a Priest or Deacon to discern a possible vocation to the Priesthood, Diaconate or the Religious life.

Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament: Each Thursday from 12:30 PM until 5:15 PM. First Friday from 5:30 PM until 7:00 PM. Rosary after the 12:00 daily Mass.

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

This was another week that passed, with some special celebrations for 9/11 that falls right before we celebrate the feast of the Exultation of The Cross on 9/14 and the Feast of Our Lady of Sorrows on 9/15. We could say is this just a coincidence ??? , or a sign to us how close God is to all who are sorrowful for whatever reason. The feasts that the Church proposes us, are supposed to bring us to the fullness of understanding of our faith and of our life. As we celebrate them, they enrich our souls and spirits, they bring us to communion with God and with other people. So we celebrate our faith in prayer and contemplation, so that later we would turn it into loving action of service to God and to others.



As it was for Saint Mother Teresa, that those two hours of adoration daily, one in the morning and one in the afternoon were moving her to that consequent service. Give until it hurts she would say. If it is not hurting it is because you didn't start giving. Her love for God, finds expression in the service to others. God gave himself to us and it manifested itself in the cross that hurts very much all those involved, yet it is that cross that saves. Blessed Mother gave her all, that manifested itself in her standing under the cross looking at her Son, Our Sorrowful Mother. How close is God to our life, how close to us is the Blessed Mother. Before we are asked to surrender our crosses, our Lord and his Mother did it first. That Cross becomes strength to those who believe. That Cross gives meaning to our crosses and sorrows. So let our faith draw us to God in prayer, and as we get filled with the love of God, than let us offer ourselves to others and to God in service.

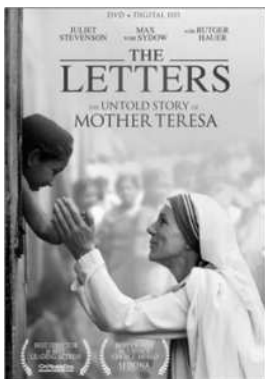
It has to be that way, that our faith becomes love in action, and this is what is so evident in the life of Saint Mother Teresa, that constant exchange between receiving Christ in the sacraments and serving him in the Church and in the poor, needy, ignorant. Saint Paul tells us in the second reading: " I ask that supplications, prayers be offered for everyone, that we may lead a quiet and tranquil life in all devotion and dignity. This is good and pleasing to God our savior, who wills everyone to be saved and to come to knowledge of the truth. "

In the Gospel, Jesus is praising a dishonest steward for acting prudently for himself in the material sense and He challenges us with it, to be prudent and laborious in the matters of the kingdom of heaven. Do all that is necessary to gain heaven. " For the children of this world are more prudent in dealing with their own generation than are the children of light. I tell you, make friends for yourselves with dishonest wealth, so that when it fails, you will be welcomed into eternal dwellings. " Jesus reminds us that we have to put God above all things since we can't love two masters this same, so our love for this world, for wealth, for personal success can't be put first before love of God.

All things will fail, but the love of God never changes and the time proves this, and we see it in the lives of the saints. Their love of God brings them to exaltation even years after death, and if people don't forget their deeds even more so the Lord, who is mindful for all who love him. May our prudence and love of God inspire us to love and to serve, because in it we will find fulfillment and happiness that our hearts so long for, be it in our personal lives, be it in the life of our family or our parish community.

Parish Outreach— September

During the month of August, we were able to assist 141 families. Within those 141 families, there were 33 seniors, 197 adults and 158 children. We had 20 new families. Thanks to your donations we were able to give our clients food and the extra toiletries they need.

Our “Back to School” drive aided 103 children. Thank you to all who kindly contributed to this drive.

We also received a generous donation of canned vegetables from our new Food Bazaar Supermarket on Wicks Road - a huge thank you to the manager, John Parks. Fr. Stan and I were invited to the Grand Opening.

The most needed items for our pantry this month are: **soups, rice, jelly and juices.**

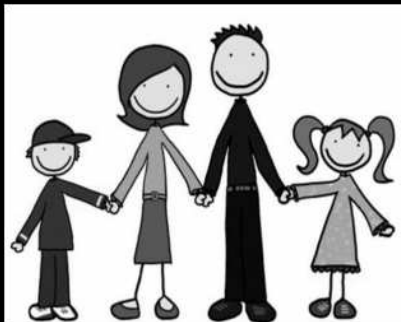

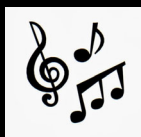
