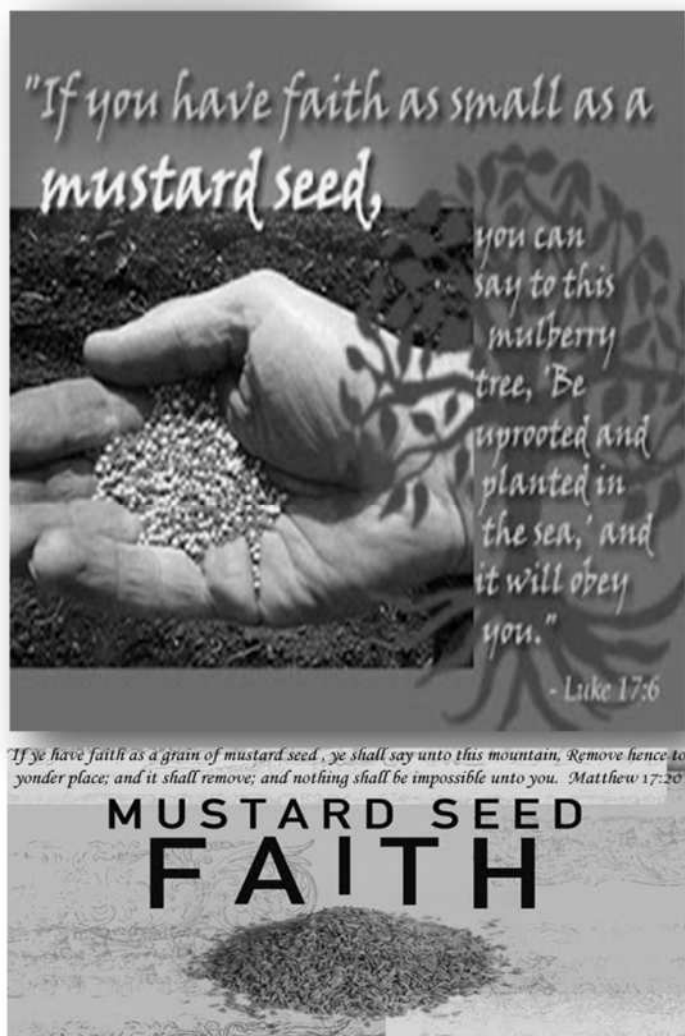

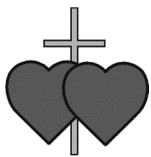

SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

Baptism: For children under 5, please contact the Parish Office (273-8113) for an appointment to speak with a Priest or Deacon at least several weeks before the Baptism. For older children, contact the Office of Family Faith Formation (231-7344).

First Holy Communion: Children usually begin Religious Education studies in the First Grade and are prepared for Communion in the Second Grade. Call the Family Faith Formation Office (231-7344) to register your child the summer before the school year begins.

Confirmation: This Sacrament is currently celebrated in the Eighth Grade after 2 years of preparation. Please call the Religious Education Office (231-7344) for more information.

SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

Sacrament of the Sick: Call the Parish Office at any time to arrange for the Anointing of the Sick either at home or in the hospital.

Reconciliation: The Sacrament is celebrated every week-day at 5:00p.m. also Saturday from 4:00 - 4:45 PM in the Church and at 8:30a.m. and 10:30 a.m. on Sundays or by appointment by calling the business office 631-273-8113.

SACRAMENTS OF VOCATION

Marriage: Congratulations! Couples planning to marry should make an appointment with a Priest or Deacon at least eight (8) months in advance of the wedding to allow time for adequate preparation.

Holy Orders: Is God calling you? Call a Priest or Deacon to discern a possible vocation to the Priesthood, Diaconate or the Religious life.

DEVOTIONS

Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament: Each Thursday from 12:30 PM until 5:15 PM. First Friday from 5:30 PM until 7:00 PM. Rosary after the 12:00 daily Mass.

Miraculous Medal Novena: Monday after the 12:00 Mass and First Saturday from 8:15 - 9:00 AM.

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

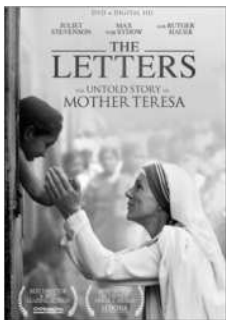
"Increase our faith" is the request of the Apostles in the Gospel of today. We all could relate to that, we all would like to have the faith as great as to move the mountains, or transplant the trees by act of faith alone. It would be nice to have the powers to do miracles, but first we need that great faith. Where do we get the faith? How do we start believing in someone or something?

We start believing in something by making good experience of it. We trust that something works out in a certain way on the basis of that experience. We know that our car is working well and that we can depend on it for transportation. But, when we go to the city, we may prefer to take the train, because we had experiences of: bad traffic, lack of parking spots, overcharging for the parking, parking tickets, traffic violations for taking wrong turn in wrong place etc. With all that, we are probably more likely to take the train and trust that this is much more peaceful solution for visiting the City. It is in those experiences that we trust or distrust ourselves or others, or the circumstances of life. Similar thing is with our faith in others. We know whom we can trust to what extent and with what, on the basis of our experience of them and their dedication to the word, to the promise, their trustworthiness. We know who can do what, we know who to trust with what.

Similar is our experience of God. We learn who God is, we learn what God does, we learn how God behaves, we get our perception and understanding of God. That perception and understanding and experience will always be limited by our humanity and our nature, but it has as well infinite possibilities, as God can give us the experience who he truly is without limits. This is why we have such a variety of saints, and each of them is different and amazing in different ways, with different virtues and deeds that make them unique.

This is what we seek in prayer, in sacraments; we seek that transforming encounter with God, with Christ, with the Holy Spirit. We wait for God to reveal himself to us so that we may reveal him to others. Are we ready for that revelation? Are we ready for that encounter? Are we ready for that transformation? The saints are ready and God transforms them because they let him do it. For others we want to control that experience too much, we want to be in charge, we want to tell God what to do, we don't get it that God knows everything and does not need our counsel, but he needs our acceptance to let him take over in our lives. This is why we come over and over to deepen our faith, our experience of God. And then when we will arrive, as the saints do; we will realize that it was the best thing to do, and that it was God's gift to us all the way, and so we would then say: "we are unprofitable servants; we have done what we were obliged to do." To seek God is our privilege, a privilege of our nature that finds its fullness in God. Sanctity, it is our calling and duty for Christians who believe in Jesus' love for us. So let us grow in faith, let us grow in our experience of faith, hope and love for God and our neighbor, and then we will become the best version of ourselves. "Lord increase our faith."

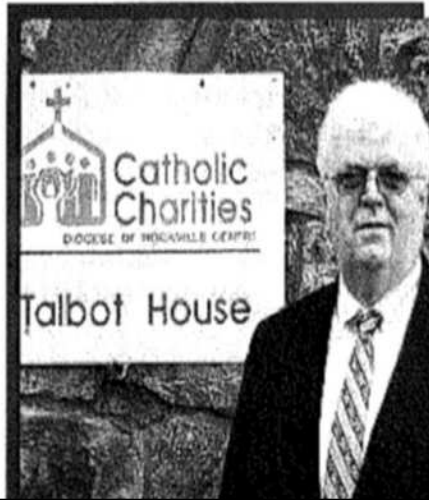

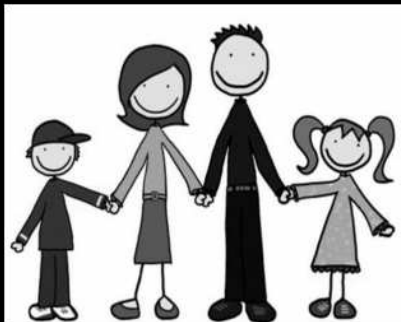

Le Pape Jean XXIII, dans son journal de âme (page 301), écrit:" Le premier trésor de mon âme, c'est la foi, la sainte foi, franche et naïve, de mes parents et de mes bons anciens. Le prophète Habakuk demande au juste la constance dans la foi. La délivrance, don de Dieu, est certaine pour qui demeure fidèle a la Parole de Dieu. C'est aussi une foi vivante et dynamique que, selon l'Evangile de Luc, Jésus demande aux disciples. Car le moindre mouvement de foi authentique vaut mieux qu'une vie entière passée a comptabiliser droits et assurances devant Dieu.
