17th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

This week we celebrated the Feast of Saint Anne, the Patron of our Parish. As tradition teaches us Saint Joachim and Saint Anne, are the parents of the Blessed Mother and grandparents of Jesus. No doubt that they had great impact on the Blessed Mother, as all parents have over their children. Who the parents are, conditions who the children will be in great part. It defines our culture we are borne into, language we will speak to express our self, world views we will be introduced to and religion that will shape our faith, although it not limits it, but predisposes us in sure way, depending on the parents capacity to transmit the knowledge and values they have. Surely there's an aspect of ones choices and grace given to each individual, yet your upbringing is fundamental to who we become as persons. So it is of importance how we get started and what is shared with us in the beginning of life.



In the Bible we find no mention of the parents of the Blessed Mother, and their names come from the apocryphal writings, that is writings that are from the time of the New Testament writings that were not included into the canon of the Bible, but that does not negate the fact, that they existed, and the tradition provides us with names. Saint Anne and Joachim would be the persons of faith is certain, as it is said that we know the tree by its fruits. Mary, the Blessed Mother being the fruit, gives us assurance of who her parents had to be, to give her strong faith, resolve, courage to be ready for the challenge of God's call to become the Mother of Jesus, the Savior of the world. Her readiness and responsibility shows nobility of her home filed with faith, placing God's things first.

Looking into the readings of this Sunday, we could say that it was the fullness of wisdom that was acquired by the cooperation with God in the household of parents of the Blessed Mother. We see God dispensing the gift of wisdom on Solomon after his heartfelt prayer requesting right judgement for the purpose of service to God's people. We can only imagine what it would be like, the prayer of Saint Anne and Joachim, that in answer to it God gave them a girl, that would become the Mother of the Savior. As Saint Paul says in the second reading: "all things work for good for those who love God ". Then we have the Gospel telling us of the treasure found in the field. It requires risk of investment. The person that finds it, goes sells all that he has and buys that field. It was that kind of commitment that Mary knew how to make in her youth, so it was somewhere, that she was disposed to learn and to listen to the Word of God, making herself available for God's plan, risking everything that she had and everything that she was.

Surely, the life of Joachim and Anne, was marked by faith and responsibility to God's plan and his work. What more can one do, than fulfill God's purpose in one's life? That is true happiness, that is true fulfillment, that is the fullness of ones life. We have a great patron of our Parish, Saint Anne is the best grandmother that Jesus could have. She is the one that created ambience for the Blessed Mother to hear the Word of God and to fulfill God's will. Let's pray for her intercession, that we be able to make our homes, our parish, our hearts a place for God to reign as it was in the home of Saint Anne and Joachim. Let the wisdom of life of that family become our wisdom and guide us all in our prayers and in our actions.

Someone said, that in our times we rush through life without enjoying the process of becoming who we are. That by thinking anxiously about the future, we forget the present, and so we live in neither the present nor the future. That we live as if we were never to die, and we die as if we had never lived. Let's make good use of our lives by enjoying every step of the way we make, by being responsible to God along the path, by enjoying the company that we share every day of our lives.

My last thoughts, we placed the Vatican and American flags in the sanctuary of our church to remind ourselves all the blessings that God gives us through the Church and through Our Country. As you look on the walls under the windows of the church they were painted by Jose Nunez and a group of volunteers, who are in the process of painting as well the entrances to the church. As well Jose replaced the floor border in the church and is replacing it in the entrances. I want to thank all of those who helped. I asked Gonzalo Marroquin to oversee the cutting of the grass around the property. As you remember he organized volunteers to clean our leaves last fall. I want to thank them for past and present help. Jose Morales helped to clean and cut bushes and landscaping areas and surely I want to thank those who weekly keep cleaning and arranging the church and flowers. Last but not least, I want to thank Kathy Fella and the Pastoral Council for organizing our Pig Roast today. In advance I thank all the Volunteers for their assistance and everyone for all the fun in coming together. ***Saint Anne pray for us !!!***

Let our gratitude for St Anne and for our parish be expressed this weekend by our community prayer at the Masses, than in coming together for the Pig Roast to enjoy each other's company remembering the saying: with whom we stand is what we become.

Here are some items our pantry needs this month: soup, Goya beans, rice, cereal, jelly, juices, pasta, sauce, toilet paper, tissues, paper towels, shampoo, conditioner, body wash, soap, deodorant, toothpaste, shaving cream, disposable razors, diapers (size 4 & 5), baby wipes, feminine hygiene products, pet food and laundry detergent.

We are requesting school supplies for the school year 2017-2018. The supply list is always very extensive: composition notebooks, #2 Ticonderoga pencils, pencil sharpeners, pens, crayons, glue, glue sticks, Fiskars scissors, highlighters, dry erase markers, thin washable markers, rulers, 3x5 ruled index cards, pencil cases, 1" and 2" binders, loose leaf paper, 2-pocket folders (laminated or plastic), lunch bags and backpacks.
