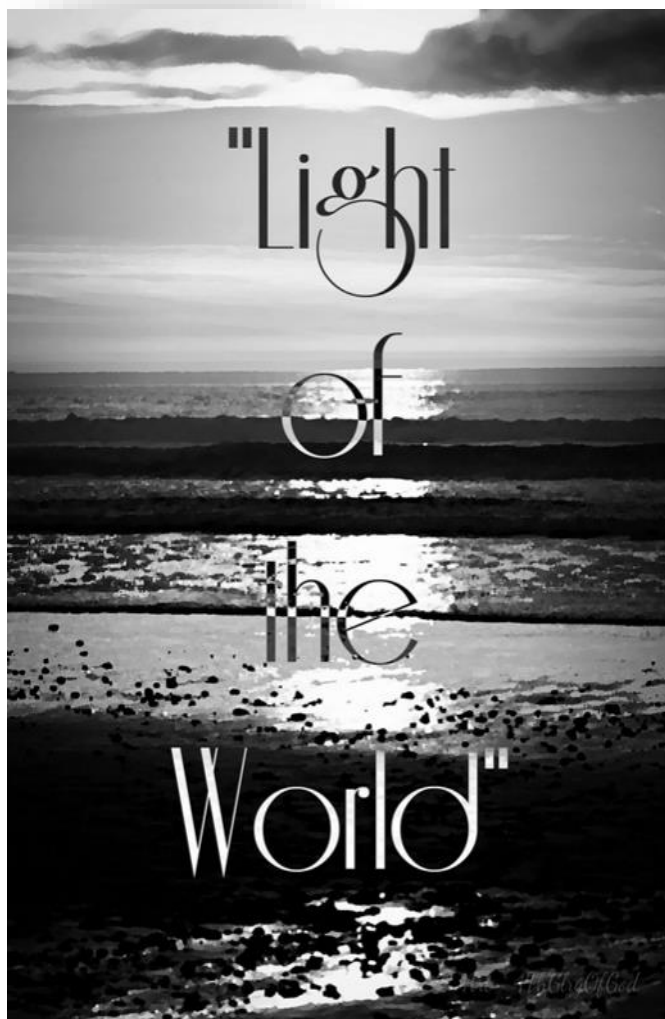

SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

Baptism: For children under 5, please contact the Parish Office (273-8113) for an appointment to speak with a Priest or Deacon at least several weeks before the Baptism. For older children, contact the Office of Family Faith Formation (231-7344).

First Holy Communion: Children usually begin Religious Education studies in the First Grade and are prepared for Communion in the Second Grade. Call the Family Faith Formation Office (231-7344) to register your child the summer before the school year begins.

Confirmation: This Sacrament is currently celebrated in the Eighth Grade after 2 years of preparation. Please call the Religious Education Office (231-7344) for more information.

SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

Sacrament of the Sick: Call the Parish Office at any time to arrange for the Anointing of the Sick either at home or in the hospital.

Reconciliation: The Sacrament is celebrated every week-day at 5:00p.m. also Saturday from 4:00 - 4:45 PM in the Church and at 8:30a.m. and 10:30 a.m. on Sundays or by appointment by calling the business office 631-273-8113.

SACRAMENTS OF VOCATION

Marriage: Congratulations! Couples planning to marry should make an appointment with a Priest or Deacon at least eight (8) months in advance of the wedding to allow time for adequate preparation.

Holy Orders: Is God calling you? Call a Priest or Deacon to discern a possible vocation to the Priesthood, Diaconate or the Religious life.

Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament: Each Thursday from 12:30 PM until 5:15 PM. First Friday from 5:30 PM until 7:00 PM. Rosary after the 12:00 daily Mass.

From the Pastors Desk:

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

"You are the salt of the earth " Mt 5:13

This statement we have heard so many times in our lives, and what a way for Jesus to make our life a parable, expressed in so few words yet speaking volumes if we ask a cook, what it may mean, or anyone preparing food and feeding other people. Jesus invites us to contemplate our lives and human life, comparing it to the function, utility, serviceability, its value and other qualities that can be ascribed to salt, which can be paralleled with human life. It is all about: purpose, nature, goal, function, essence, destiny, role, that our life plays in the life of the world, and in the life of other people.



What does the salt do? : gives the taste, sharpens it, exalts the taste of food. Salt preserves and conserves food. Salt has healing qualities. Salt cleans and disinfects. Salt absorbs humidity, too much of it may be toxic. Its amount in water may kill life as it is in Dead Sea. Its amount in the water of Dead Sea makes it easy to swim in it or rather float on its surface.

What is the secret of the salt ? What is the best way to use it and to get the maximum of what salt can give? It is in the right usage, right balance, that the salt gives its best to the user and so fulfilling the purpose for which it is sought and used.

Our lives supposed to give taste to life of the world and to life of others. Life of each one of us is unique and irreparable and each of us is to judge what that means, and we can show to the world how do we interpret the meaning of those words and we can make it shine in the world. No institution is better than what Jesus established, his Church, makes those words shine to the rest of the world for times to come and for eternity. And it is by the grace of God, that the Saints continue their mission and participation in the life of the Church long after they are gone. The saltiness of life of a Saint lives in the life of Church. The Saints find their imitators and followers ages after they are gone. Wow !!! How attractive is that saltiness, that taste given by the example of their lives. It is that personal interpretation of the Gospel, that becomes visible to all, to be tasted by all who seek " the salt of the earth and the light of the world ".

Today as I am writing this reflection, the living Church gives us the opportunity to taste the saltiness in the life of our new Bishop John O. Barres. The history of his family and faith journey of his parents, shows the search for the taste of the Gospel. Bishop John is going to share with us the fruits of that search, the fruits of his journey and vocation. In his inaugural address, Bishop John Barres invited all of us, to participate in the re-evangelization of our Diocese, in the re-evangelization of our parishes and our households, by inviting one person back to church before the March 1st. March 1st is Ash Wednesday, the beginning of Lent and it will come fast. So whom are you going to invite to church? Are you willing to bring someone to Christ? Are you going to be "the salt of the earth " or you prefer to be tasteless, like the snow melt, ready to be thrown away to be walked upon? How will you respond to that invitation? Whom will you invite to come to church? That is going to be the question that I will be asking you the next time we meet. I believe it is a very good way to see what evangelization is. We all want to bring to Christ those with whom we want to spend heaven with. We don't want to be in heaven alone. And we don't want to go to hell to look for our friends and family, we need to get them on the Lord's side now. So let's do it! Let's bring someone to Christ. Let's bring all to Christ!!!

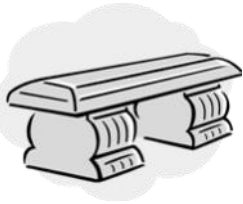

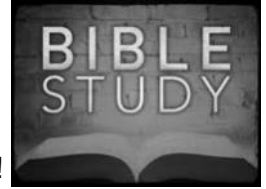

From the Deacons Bench

Where does the time go? We've packed up the Christmas decorations, put away the gift wrap and await the credit card bills! Thoughts turn from Christmas to Ordinary time, to dare I say:
Lent (which is just around the corner)!



With that in mind, I would like to invite you to a Saint Anne's tradition, as we will again turn to study God's Word. That's right, Adult Bible study is returning. We will begin our study on February 27, 2017. We will begin at 7pm in the study room located in the basement of the rectory.

Our study will focus on the Eucharist in Sacred Scripture. We will read about how sacrifice was depicted in the Old Testament, how and why Bread and Wine were used by Jesus to go from an agricultural product to His own Body and Blood. We will see how the early Christian communities attempted to understand the great mystery of the Eucharist. The great Gift of the Lord Himself to us. For us.

The Bible study will last for six weeks. The first evening serves as an introduction, as a bit of "basic training" as to how we might approach the study of the Word of God. If you never picked up a Bible before, no worries, the Study is geared for all levels of experience. By the end of the first session I guarantee you will be all set to dive into the Bible.

What you have to do is to bring your curiosity, and desire along with a commitment to pray and read from the course materials- about 20 minutes a day. To reflect on some aspects of the study material to help guide your deepening knowledge of the Eucharist, and bring your questions to our sessions. There, I will, hopefully, answer them during our discussion.

I do sincerely hope you will take advantage of this Lenten Study. Lent is a wonderful time to center our selves, to return to who we really are. The People of God. A people of the Word.
