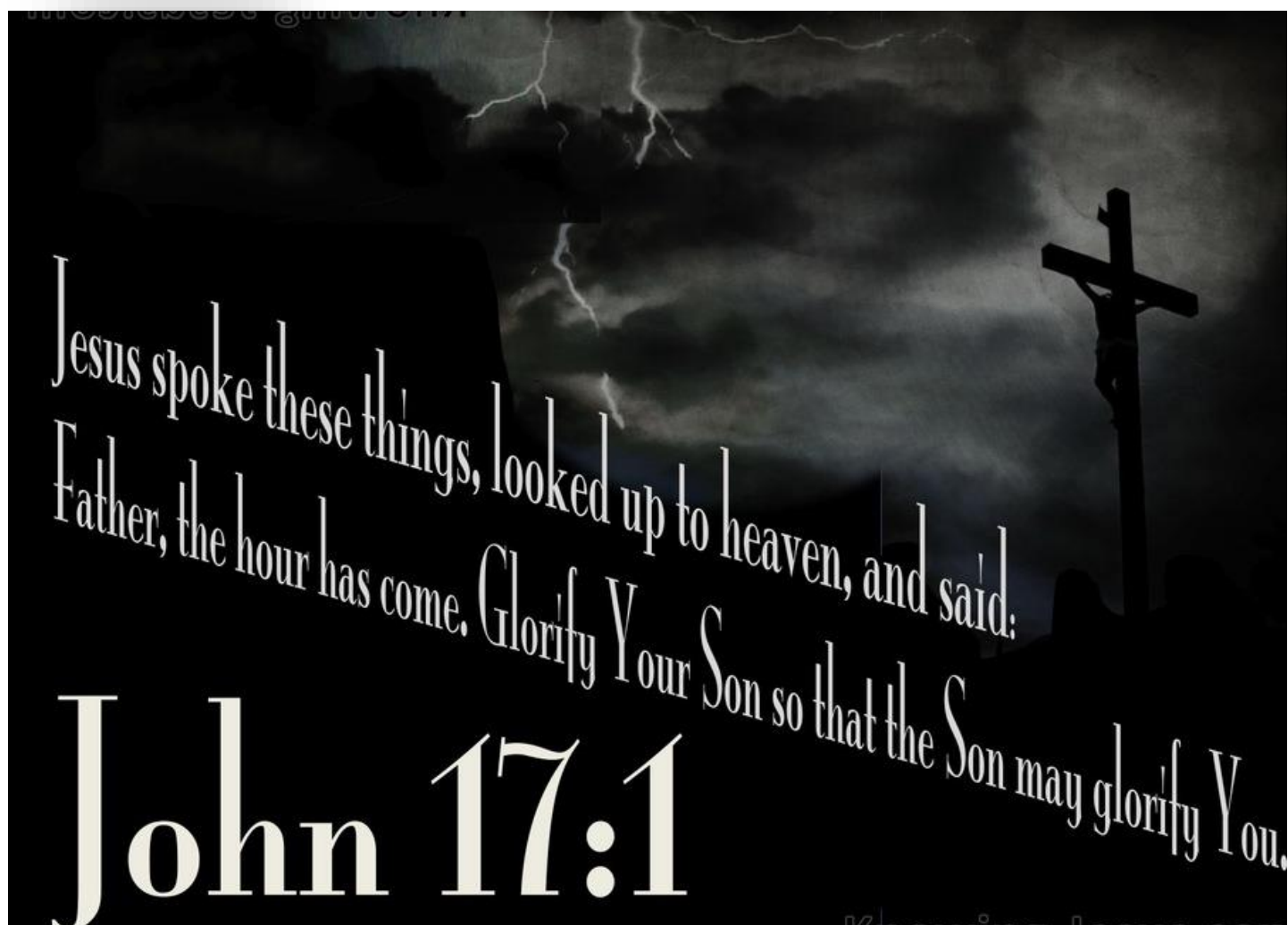

From the Pastor- Fr. Stan

May 28, 2017

Dear Sisters and Brothers,



Last Thursday we had celebrated the Ascension of Christ to the glory of heaven. Something, that in the Gospel of this Sunday, Jesus foretells or is praying for: "Father - now glorify me, with you, with the glory that I had with you before the world began. " Jesus longs to go where he was before the creation of the world, and Jesus wants to take us with himself, to that glory of heaven.

But before he ascended to heaven, he left us with instructions to follow. It is beautiful to see how the transition happened from the time when Jesus walked this earth, to his departure to the glory of heaven as he foretold before. That transition time, applies to us also, as we live in the time after Jesus walked the paths of this earth for the first time. So, that time in between, gives us much information about the perspective of that new situation, and the dynamics of upcoming reality in which we are participants. So if we want to find our place in the new reality of life when Christ is primarily in heaven and we yet on earth, we need to examine the - in between - stage of the Church, that would show us the responsibility that Christ puts on his disciples.

We want to realize, that we are in the group of disciples left behind to accomplish what Jesus intended for the salvation of all humanity, by our assuming personal responsibility for our faith and for the faith of others. Our faith is an expression of our heart and mind, is an expression of our freedom and choice, that applied itself to the good of the Gospel, and it becomes an expression of the love that we find within ourselves. And that is what Jesus wants to accomplish in us, he wants to inspire us by faith in Him and in God, to become a source of love and faith for others, and that chain of love and faith Jesus wants to propose to every creature on the face of the earth, because Jesus wants everyone to partake of the glory of God in Heaven. For that purpose Jesus needs you and me to accomplish it, to bring his love and faith to the ends of the earth, or to the outskirts of life, to those that are marginalized and pushed out of mainstream of life. Only experience of love can inspire us to faith and love in return. Jesus wants that chain of love and of faith to embrace the whole of humanity. That, unselfish love of Christ is supposed to be the source of faith and love for all those who believe. What stops that process of evangelization, is the selfishness of the one that refuses to love, that refuses to put into practice the faith, that refuses to believe because of self clouded judgement about who God is and oneself. When we stop the process, we kind of take the first place for ourselves and keep it for the selfish reasons of vain glory or for personal self absorbed enjoyment without consideration for the other people and for our own destiny of gaining heaven. Reading the readings of Ascension and after we realize the challenge that Jesus is putting on us to be engaged, to put our personal agenda to the side and start working on God's agenda, which is the only long term agenda that will work for everyone for the best, for the salvation of all.

Am I in ??? Am I joining the Lords agenda ??? Or will I persist with my own ??? - Just me - it's all about me - it's all about you - how many times we did hear that ??? Rather, it's all about us, it's all about everyone, how can we be brothers and sisters to each other, so that we would prove ourselves worthy of the glory of heaven, of the sacrifice of the Cross, worthy to be called God's children.

So I encourage you to go back to the readings of Ascension Thursday, and ponder the mystery of that transition, that Jesus draws us into and in which time we still live, as we didn't reach heaven yet. So let's not set ourselves behind pretending that we are staying here on earth always, because we know that it is unrealistic and unreasonable. We are closer to heaven everyday, and nothing that we do can stop that process. Let's make it fun by cooperating in it with the Lord, and this will be the best what we can do, and the most realistic of all choices to take. " The eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain to which Jesus had ordered them. When they saw him, they worshiped, but they doubted. Then Jesus approached and said to them, "All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age. " Mt 28: 16-20 In the Acts of the Apostles 1:1-11 we get St Luke's beautiful account of what happened on that day.

Let's take the invitation to be counted in.

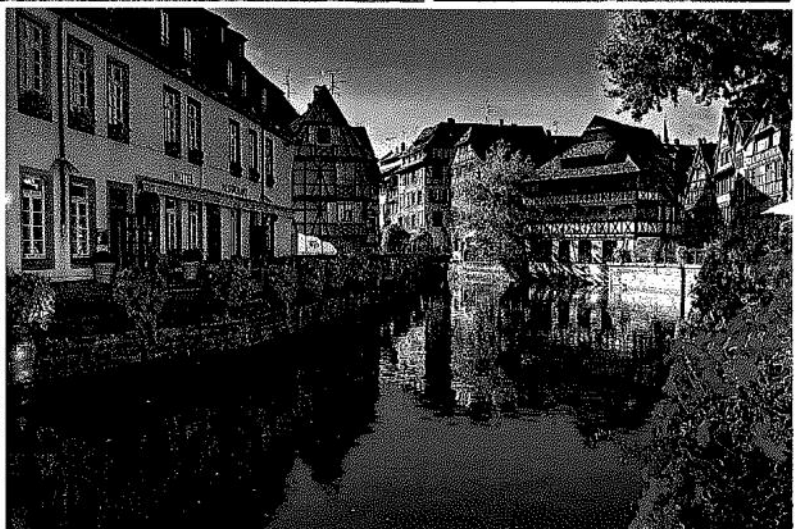
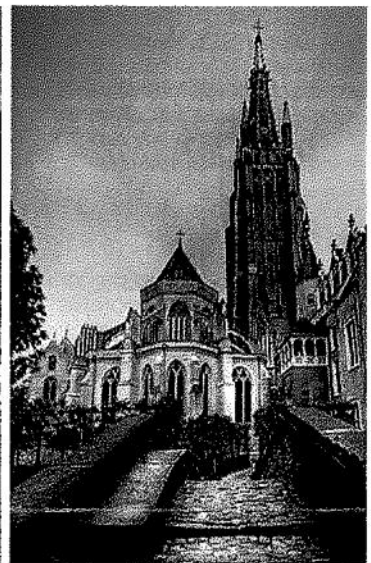
