From the Pastor- Fr. Stan

June 4, 2017



Dear Sisters and Brothers,

We had a good Memorial weekend, and even if the weather was not the best, the occasion to celebrate was so noble, as we remembered the fallen soldiers that sacrificed their lives for our freedom and the freedom of the world. There is no greater love than when one gives his life for his friends, Jesus said. So they made it to the glory. They were prepared by their courage and love, but not necessarily by the timing of the sacrifice, that often seemed to early for those who stayed behind. Thank You fallen servicemen and women for your gift.

You and I were left behind by the Lord for the purpose, for the goal of bearing good fruits of our faith. Jesus promised the gift of the Holy Spirit to the disciples and St. John describes in the Gospel how : "he breathed on them and said to them, receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained. " Jesus gives the Apostles the authority of his mercy. To be able to forgive sins is a big authority shared by Jesus himself. That capacity to purify our hearts, is a good step to finding the peace for oneself and peace for the world. Everyone gets the opportunity for finding peace and reconciliation. Isn't that what we want ? To be able to live in peace with ourselves and with one another ???

This week on the news we had multiple reports of violent explosions around the world, aiming at killing of innocent people. Just killing for the sake of violence. It is hard to keep track of how many of those events occurred, and how many victims they produced. How far is that from the promises of the Gospel, from the proposition of Christ and his example to serve and not to be served. It is great hatred spreading around the world, a tactic of fear and intimidation. Something that we experienced in our community through gang violence. It's wrong, it's totally wrong. And it is wrong to fight those evils by political correctness. In this way we will never be able to resolve it, because political correctness it is another form of mental violence that opposes the truth. Political correctness feeds on violence, fear and false accusations; it uses false excuses for itself, same as the false excuses used by the bombers and violent crimes perpetrators.

Our world needs Christ in order to have peace and justice. Jesus said to Thomas : "I am the truth, and the way and the life , no one comes to the father except through me. " Jesus gives his life as a proof of his words. Only in him we find salvation. Without reverence for God we can't build an order on earth. It will be like building a Tower of Babel, it will confuse and divide people, because the wrong or evil goal can't unite people in peace and harmony, only truth can.

Saint Paul tells us today that: No one can say, "Jesus is Lord, " except by the Holy Spirit. That is the best test for having the gift of Holy Spirit. If you can say " Jesus is Lord " God's Spirit dwells within you and you have the gifts of the Holy Spirit to pray for and to ask for.

There are 7 gifts of the Holy Spirit : wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of the Lord (wonder). Is 11: 2-3.

There are 12 fruits of the Holy Spirit working in us as the tradition of the Church teaches us, they are observable behaviors of people who have allowed the grace of the Holy Spirit to be effective in them. They are: charity and generosity, joy and gentleness, peace and faithfulness, patience and modesty, kindness and self control, goodness and chastity. CCC 1832.

As we can see, we have much to pray for to acquire all gifts and fruits of the Holy Spirit. We want him to mold us into the persons that the Lord wants us to be. Are we those persons yet ??? Are we transformed by the grace of Christ. Are we like him yet ??? We need to pray the prayer of Saint Francis : "Lord, make me a channel of your peace ..".

God bless everyone with the gift of the Holy Spirit !!!!

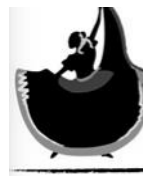

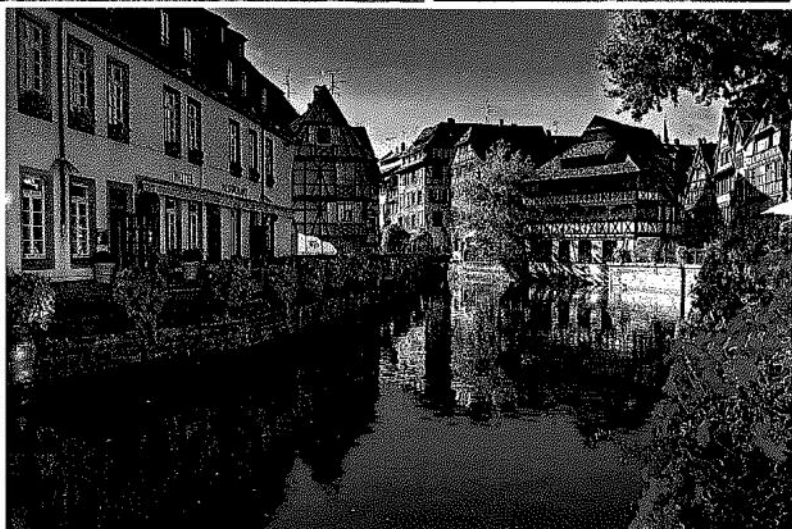
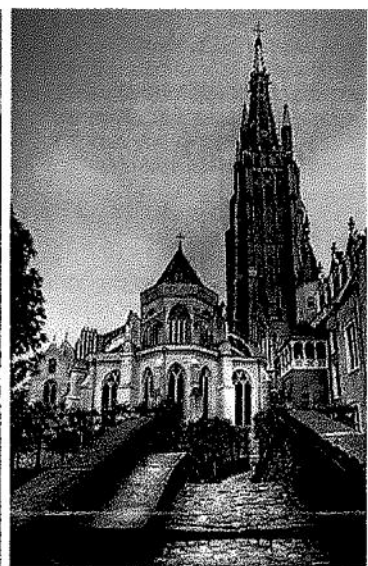

Ils furent tous remplis du Saint Esprit

Le récit de la Pentecôte, dans le livre des Actes des Apôtres, fait d'abord état d'un violent coup de vent. Ne fallait-il pas un souffle puissant pour secouer des esprits figes et relier des langues muettes? Une pluie de feu n'était-elle pas nécessaire pour embraser les disciples glaces par la peur? Seul l'Esprit de Dieu pouvait faire sortir ces hommes traqués de leur refuge.
