From the Pastor- Fr. Stan

June 18, 2017



Dear Sisters and Brothers,

This weekend we celebrate a double feast: of our earthly celebration of Father's Day and a heavenly celebration of Corpus Christi, that is of the Body and Blood of Christ who became the bread for our salvation. Both of the celebrations have great implications for our lives, as each of us has a father, and each of us is saved by Christ. These two mysteries permeate our lives for the whole of its extent. We may be conscious of it in our daily lives, or forgetful in the businesses of life that we create around ourselves. But even if we would forget those realities, they will continue to affect everyday of our existence now and in eternity. Because they refer to persons on whom our existence totally depends, and they are in no way of stopping loving us. Thinking of our parents - we just celebrated Mother's Day - and of Christ, we think of the persons that gave us this life and eternity. What more could we ask for ??? What more could anyone give us ???

In this, lies the secret of this weekend, and we are invited to ponder these mysteries, and they should inspire our awe and contemplation, than action, or rather relationship, because they are very much alive. Our God is a God of living not of the dead. This is why, we should be the best of the person that we can be, if we are mature enough to keep those relationships going. If our parents are alive, let's be attentive to them. If they died, let's pray for them, let's offer Mass intentions for them, that is the most that we can give to someone, the gift of God himself. Those three relationships will always affect our lives, and they will enrich us and make us persons of love. Let us stay engaged, and they will transform us into the saints, as it was the intent of God himself at the creation.

Corpus Christi is a reminder to us of this living mystery of Christ's presence in the life of the world. When we get to heaven we will then understand, how Jesus presence in us and in our world, was impacting our life, and how it nourishes us for eternal life. As our blood runs through our veins and brings nourishment to all cells of the body, so the blood of Jesus nourishes our soul, with nourishment of eternity. Lord give us this food always - the disciples said when Jesus talked to them about the bread of eternal life.

I don't know if you ever read about the Eucharistic miracles, when the host is changed into the real body, the real human tissue. There are many of those events in the history of the church on the extent of the ages. There are even some people, that ate only Eucharist and lived for years on this heavenly diet. Is it possible to live just on the little Host ??? Humanly it's impossible, but by the grace of God, yes. It is the cooperation of faith with God's grace. It's miracle of love and of life that God bestowed on some, so that we might believe in what Jesus is giving us. To foster our faith, the church invites us to make Corpus Christi processions. We will have had our procession after 7:00pm Mass this Saturday. We have as well our weekly adoration on every Thursday afternoon. We have some extra adoration for First Fridays also. This is why I tried to make sometimes even on Sunday, the moment of adoration on the end of Mass, with the benediction with the Blessed Sacrament, to raise our awareness of the Presence of Jesus in it. It can be done by skipping the homily and making it as meditation in front of the Blessed Sacrament, so the Mass doesn't get longer and we get the occasion to make some more personal connection with the Eucharistic presence of Jesus.

Can I live on Host alone ? - no, can you live on the Host alone ? - probably not, but we certainly can be more devoted and reverent towards Jesus in the Eucharist, present always at Mass and later in the Tabernacle. One of the great Saints devoted to the Eucharist was St Joseph of Cupertino. Read on his incredible life experiences. The origins of the Corpus Christi processions goes back to Eucharistic miracles as well, and was first established in Universal Church in 1264 by Pope Urban IV. Let's open ourselves to the knowledge and experience of those realities and they will greatly affect and transform our lives.

Just for the record, I gave one of our monstrance/ the stand in which we place a Host for adoration/ the small one, to our new Bishop John Barres, as after his first visit to our parish, the Bishop's Secretary Msgr. Morrissey, noted he was looking for one for the Bishop. Our Bishop likes to daily make his adoration time so I was informed. Next time he comes to our parish, you may ask him personally about his devotion.



ST. ANNE'S THOMAS CONERTY OUTREACH

The generosity of the parishioners of St. Anne Parish allows us to reach out to people in our Brentwood/Bay Shore neighborhood who struggle each day to make ends meet. Thank you to all who generously donate to our food pantry. During May 2017, we were happy to assist 122 families, 24 seniors, 158 adults and 147 children. We also helped 11 new families.

On May 15th, we received an abundant amount of non-perishable food from the U.S. Postal Carriers. Their annual "Stamp Out Hunger" food drive does help to feed many in our area. Thanks to all who donated food to this event on May 13th.

School is almost finished for the year and the outreach is now requesting school supplies for the school year 2017-2018. The supply list is always very extensive: composition notebooks, Ticonderoga #2 pencils, pens, crayons, glue, glue sticks, Fiscar scissors, highlighters, dry erase markers, thin washable markers, rulers, ruled index cards, pencil cases, 1" and 2" binders, loose leaf paper, 2-pocket folders (laminated or plastic), lunch bags and backpacks. Any donated school supply item will be gratefully appreciated.

Here are some items we need this month: soup, Goya beans, cereal, jelly (small jars), juices, toilet paper, tissues, paper towels, shampoo, conditioner, body wash, soap, deodorant, toothpaste, shaving cream, disposable razors, diapers (size 4 & 5), baby wipes, feminine hygiene products, pet food and laundry detergent. Le vrai pain des enfants de Dieu

Sous le signe du pain et du vin eucharistiques nous communions au corps et au sang du Christ, c'est-a-dire au sacrifice de La Croix ou Jésus livre son corps et verse son sang pour nous. "L'homme ne vit pas seulement de pain." Tel fut, pour la première lecture, le message inhérent au don merveilleux de la manne dans le désert. Cette longue traversée, Dieu l'a imposée au peuple hébreu pour lui apprendre la pauvreté et la confiance. Voila la toile de fond sur laquelle se détache l'enseignement de Jésus dans l'évangile de Jean. Pain de Dieu offert aux hommes pour "que le monde ait la vie." Jésus se donne lui-même en nourriture à ceux qui croient en Lui. Lui, qui est venu pour servir, est allé jusqu'au bout de son don de soi. Ce pain-la, c'est le corps du Christ que nous recevons à la communion et que, simultanément, nous sommes conviés à édifier la ou nous vivons. C'est ce que Paul dit en termes inoubliables dans l'épître d'aujourd'hui. "La multitude que nous sommes est un seul corps, car nous avons tous part à un seul pain." L'unique pain eucharistique est ainsi le signe efficace de notre union au Christ et de notre communion fraternelle.
