

The Transfiguration of the Lord

Dear Sisters and Brothers,





Our pantry shelves are very sparsely filled. If each parishioner brought in one non-perishable food item, it would help us to feed the hungry in our community.

Here are some items our pantry needs this month: soup, Goya beans, rice, cereal, jelly, juices, pasta, sauce, toilet paper, tissues, paper towels, shampoo, conditioner, body wash, soap, deodorant, toothpaste, shaving cream, disposable razors, diapers (size 4 & 5), baby wipes, feminine hygiene products, pet food and laundry detergent.

We are requesting school supplies for the school year 2017-2018. Thank you for caring for the poor in our parish community.







Donnez-leur vous-mêmes a manger

D'après l'oracle prophétique rapporte par la première lecture, Dieu invite ceux qui ont faim et soif a se rassasier de mets succulents, et cela "sans rien payer". Le Seigneur vient au-delà des attentes de son peuple et le comble gratuitement. L'Evangile d' aujourd'hui comment la libéralité de Dieu s'exerce a travers le geste de Jésus multipliant les pains. Tous ayant mange a leur

faim, "on ramassa douze paniers pleins avec les morceaux qui restaient", ce qui est une marque éloquente de la surabondance divine. Mais la clé du récit est fournie par l'opposition entre le verbe "acheter" et le verbe "donner". Aux disciples suggérant que les gens aillent s'acheter a manger, Jésus réplique: Donnez-leur vous-mêmes a manger. Tout est dans ce renversement, qui substitue le partage a la transaction commerciale.

"Donnez-leur vous-mêmes a manger", L'appel de Jesus est toujours actuel pour nous.
