

11TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

In the Gospel for this Sunday, Jesus compares the Kingdom of God to sewing of a seed, that thrown into the ground sprouts and grows, and brings the fruit. The seed accomplishes its purpose by multiplying and becoming a food for others. And so it is with mustard seed, that even though very small becomes a large plant giving shade and hiding place to many birds. The power of life that is enclosed in the seed, is compared to the power that is found in the word of God. The word of God that is sown in the hearts of man has the power: to multiply, to grow, to nurture, to give rest and hiding place for those who seek refuge in God.



As the power of life is enclosed in every seed, so the power of life is enclosed in every word of God. Jesus invites us to receive God's word as the seed of eternal life. The word of God that is planted in the hearts of man, brings the presence of the kingdom of God on earth. It influences our thoughts, then it influences our actions, and so it expands from that seed within our hearts, to the fruits of good deeds that we shared with others. The expansion of the word of God from a seed in our mind and heart, to a physical deed and an act of love, that is the transformation of the kingdom of God in our midst. That is the power of life and power of love, that was brought about by an act of faith. That power to move us from word to action is enclosed in the seed of the word of God. That word, becomes love in action through our faith. The fruitfulness of God's word in our life depends on our faith and love for God and for others.

When we look on the lives of saints, we find this great capacity to give fruits of faith and of love. Their faith becomes a shelter and place of refuge for those who seek the Lord. The example of their lives becomes a seed of faith for those who witness it, and it becomes an encouragement to grow in faith, hope and love and so to bring more fruits. It becomes a chain of faith, it becomes a chain of deeds, and it becomes a chain of love.

This is how our faith has to become an action of kindness and love. This is how the power of faith transforms the word of God into reality of God's kingdom in our midst. Mother Theresa would say, that we need to find time for God and God will accomplish his work in us. We need to quiet down because in silence we find God. She would say:

*The fruit of silence is prayer
the fruit of prayer is faith
the fruit of faith is a love
the fruit of love his service
the fruit of service is peace and joy.*

And so each one of us can find a way to make the word of God fruitful in our lives, and bring fruits that will last for eternal life. Let's get busy on making it happen by starting with silence and prayer as Mother Teresa suggested us, and than we will be part of the transformation that she brought to our world by works of love.

This Sunday we celebrate as well Father's Day. **HAPPY FATHERS DAY** to all who have fathered children, be it physically or by adoption.

What a great way of becoming fruitful by becoming a parent! It is a great task that never ends. It is a call, it is a mission, it is definitely an act of love. It is as well very complex call, because of all human and spiritual implications. Fatherhood is a source of great joy and satisfaction, but as well source of suffering and pain. All depends on relationship between parents and children, as well as on circumstances of life that may be totally beyond any human control. So it is a great call, great responsibility, and a great challenge.

Let's pray for all Fathers, that they will be blessed in all things, from health, material prosperity, to spiritual satisfaction of fulfillment and happiness coming from correspondence of children to their love.

Let us pray as well for all Fathers who have died, may the Lord in his mercy forgive them all mistakes and sins and in his kindness, reward all good deeds and love they shared with others.

SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

Baptism: For children under 5, please contact the Parish Office (273-8113) for an appointment to speak with a Priest or Deacon at least several weeks before the Baptism. For older children, contact the Office of Family Faith Formation (231-7344).

First Holy Communion: Children usually begin Religious Education studies in the First Grade and are prepared for Communion in the Second Grade. Call the Family Faith Formation Office (231-7344) to register your child the summer before the school year begins.

Confirmation: This Sacrament is currently celebrated in the Eighth Grade after 2 years of preparation. Please call the Religious Education Office (231-7344) for more information.

SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

Sacrament of the Sick: Call the Parish Office at any time to arrange for the Anointing of the Sick either at home or in the hospital.

Reconciliation: The Sacrament is celebrated every Saturday from 4:00 - 4:45 PM in the Church or by appointment.

SACRAMENTS OF VOCATION

Marriage: Congratulations! Couples planning to marry should make an appointment with a Priest or Deacon at least eight (8) months in advance of the wedding to allow time for adequate preparation.

Holy Orders: Is God calling you? Call a Priest or Deacon to discern a possible vocation to the Priesthood, Diaconate or the Religious life.


