31st Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

As we read in the Gospel on this Sunday, Jesus continues to meet and come towards those who seek him. But even more, as he says: "the Son of Man has come to seek and to save what was lost." To seek and to save, this almost sounds like a commandment, specially when we think that this is regarding human persons and not

material things. As Jesus says to Zacchaeus: "come down quickly, for today I must stay at your house." I must - it is a definitive statement and again a commend, to be with the one that Jesus was seeking to save.



How urgent and persistent Jesus is in accomplishing his mission of seeking and saving. His actions are very concrete and definitive, his concern is genuine and generous in doing what is necessary; and as we learn through the reading, Jesus is already criticized for associating with Zacchaeus, and this accusations only get worse and ultimately end with condemnation to death, which Jesus does not avoid and surrenders his own life to his accusers.

This commandment: "to seek and to save", was of greater importance to Jesus than to save his own life. This urgency, this importance to find Zacchaeus is Jesus' answer to any person seeking him. As much as the seekers long to see, to find Jesus, even more so Jesus wants to find and save them. Jesus manifests this attitude to the very end of his life, when on the cross he expressed his longing to save everyone by his cry: "I thirst!" Jesus desire is not to drink, but to save. As he said before: "I did not come to be served, but to serve and to give my life as a ransom for many." Jesus pours out his life on us from the tree of the cross, straight from his open heart. Here it is, a gift of God's love and mercy. Take it; this is my body given up for you, this is my blood poured out for you and for many. Thank you Jesus for your courage, and selfless love and for your desire to seek and to save us.

In 2 Cor. 5:14-15, Saint Paul writes us: "For the love of Christ urges us on, because we are convinced that one has died for all; therefore all have died. And he died for all, so that those who live might live no longer for themselves, but for him who died and was raised for them." How blessed are we to be sought, found and saved by Jesus. Jesus you're mine and I am yours. Jesus I trust in you, I give you my life, my soul, my all, I love you !!! Don't let me fall from your hands. Jesus save me!

Let this be the answer of each one of us who seek, who want to see, who want to meet Jesus. How sad and tragic was the message of the Vietnamese girl who died with the other 38 persons inside of the tractor trailer in England, gasping for air, she wrote: "I am dying, I can't breathe," the text read. Nothing more was heard from her. How sadly can life end, how dramatically can one's dreams be shattered. Let us pray for all victims of human tragedies and their families, may they find rest in Christ Jesus!!!

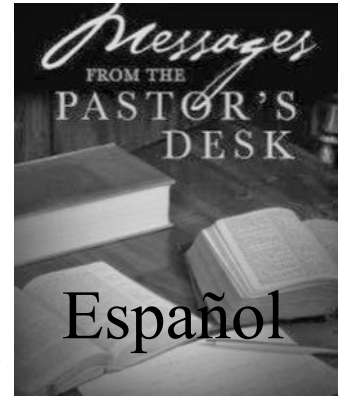

Queridas Hermanas y Hermanos:

Mientras leemos en el Evangelio este Domingo, Jesús continua encontrándose y viniendo hacia aquellos que lo buscan. Pero aun mas , como el dice: “el Hijo del Hombre ha venido a buscar y salvar lo perdido”. Buscar y salvar, esto casi suena como un mandamiento, especialmente cuando pensamos que se trata de personas humanas y no de cosas materiales. Como Jesús le dice a Zaqueo: “baja rápidamente, porque hoy debo quedarme en tu casa”. Debo – es una declaración definitiva y nuevamente una recomendación, estar con el que Jesús estaba tratando de salvar.



Cuan urgente y persistente es Jesús al cumplir su misión de buscar y salvar. Su acción es muy concreta y definitiva, su preocupación es genuina y generosa al hacer lo necesario; y mientras aprendemos con la lectura, Jesús ya es criticado por asociarse con Zaqueo, y estas acusaciones solo reciben peor y finalmente termina con la condena a muerte, que Jesús no evita y entrega su propia vida a sus acusadores.

Este mandamiento: “buscar y salvar”, fue de mayor importancia para Jesús que para salvar su propia vida. Esta urgencia, esta importancia de encontrar a Zaqueo es la respuesta de Jesús a cualquier persona que lo busque. Por mucho que los buscadores anhelan ver, encontrar a Jesús, aun mas, quiere encontrarlos y salvarlos. Jesús manifiesta esta actitud hasta el final de su vida, cuando en la cruz expreso su anhelo de salvar a todos con su grito “! Tengo Sed!” El deseo de Jesús no es beber, sino salvar. Como dijo antes: “No vine a ser servido, sino a servir y a dar mi vida en rescate por muchos”. Jesús derrama su vida desde el árbol de la cruz, directamente desde su corazón abierto. Aquí es un regalo del amor y la misericordia de Dios. Tómallo; este es mi cuerpo entregado por ti, esta es mi sangre derramada por ti y por muchos. Gracias Jesús por tu coraje y amor desinteresado y por tu deseo de buscarnos y salvarnos. En Cor. 5;14-15, San Pablo nos escribe: “Porque el amor de Cristo nos urge, porque estamos convencidos de que uno ha muerto por todos; por lo tanto, todos han muerto. Y el murió por todos, para que los que viven puedan vivir ya no para ellos, sino para el que murió y fue resucitado para ellos.”

¡Cuan bendecidos debemos ser buscados, encontrados y salvados por Jesús!

Jesús, ere mío y yo soy tuyo. ¡Jesús, confié en ti, te doy mi vida, mi alma, mi todo, te amo! No me dejes caer de tus manos. ¡Jesús sálvame! Que esta sea la respuesta de cada uno de nosotros que buscamos, queremos ver, queremos conocer a Jesús. Que triste y trágico fue el mensaje de la Niña vietnamita que murió con 38 personas mas dentro del camión en Inglaterra, jadeando por aire, escribió: “Me estoy muriendo, no puedo respirar”, decía el texto. Nada mas se supo de ella. Cuan tristemente puede terminar la vida, cuan dramáticamente pueden romperse los sueños. Oremos por todas las victimas de las tragedias humanas y sus familias, ¡que puedan descansar en Cristo Jesús!

DOMINGO XXXI DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

Sab 11:22-12:2 Sal 144 2Tes 1:11-2:2 Lc 19:1-10

A la liturgia de este domingo la han antecedido tres fiestas importantes: Santos Simón y Judas, día de los Fieles difuntos y el día de todos los Santos. Nos detenemos en los últimos: los Santos. La Iglesia celebrar en un solo día a los testigos de la Fe, incluye a todos aquellos que por medio de la Canonización han llegado a los altares y a todos aquellos testigos anónimos que nunca tendrán una imagen que los represente. Especial mención podemos hacer de St. John Henry Newman, pero también de Dulce López Pontes (primera santa brasileña).

La perspectiva escatológica está presente en las lecturas de los últimos domingos del año. La venida de Cristo tiene dos momentos: en la humildad de la carne (cf. Lc 1,26-28), otra en poder y gloria (cf. Ap 1:7-8). Sin embargo, los Padres de la Iglesia, sucesores de los Apóstoles, afirmaron una venida intermedia a través de las mediaciones de la Iglesia: la Escritura, los Sacramentos, la Comunidad, los Pobres, etc. El Hijo del Hombre ha venido a buscar y a salvar lo que estaba perdido (cf. Lc 19:1-10). Se nos presenta un hecho real, el de Zaqueo publicano y recaudador de impuestos que movido por la curiosidad quiso conocer a Jesús, luego la cercanía del mismo suscito su conversión. ¿Que suscita en nosotros el relato del Evangelio? Y si nos dice algo ¿ Cuáles son las acciones que vamos a emprender?
