Dear Sisters and Brothers,

Today's readings invite us into an honest and hopeful dialogue about faith in times of struggle. The prophet Habakkuk voices the question of many: "How long, Lord?"—when injustice and suffering seem unchecked. God's response, though not immediate, points us to a future hope: "the righteous one shall live by faith."

In the Gospel, the disciples' request, "Increase our faith," is as urgent and sincere today as it was two thousand years ago. They had seen Jesus heal the sick, forgive the sinners, and challenge the leaders. They knew that such a life of discipleship would require courage and trust beyond their own strength. So they begged for more faith. Jesus' reply may surprise us. He doesn't hand them a grand strategy or promise instant power. Instead, he points to something tiny: faith like a mustard seed. A seed seems small and insignificant, but in God's hands it carries immense potential. Even the smallest act of trust—spoken prayer in a difficult moment, forgiveness offered when it hurts, showing up to serve when tired—can become something far greater than we imagine. What God can do is beyond our control and measure.

Jesus also tells a parable about servants who simply do their duty without expecting special thanks. Here he reminds us that faith is not about prestige or entitlement; it is about humble service. Faith grows not by dramatic displays, but by steady fidelity: praying daily, loving patiently, serving quietly, forgiving readily. This Gospel asks us to rethink what we mean by "great faith." True faith is not about quantity, but about surrender. It is the courage to entrust even our small efforts to God's power, and the humility to serve without seeking recognition. As we go through the week, let us remember: a little faith, sincerely lived, can move mountains—because God is the one who makes it grow and makes things happen.

St. Paul's words to Timothy strengthen us: the gifts God has given us are not to be hidden but kindled, lived out in courage, integrity, and perseverance. In our daily lives, we are called to live faithfully, trusting that God is at work even when we do not see it fully.

Key Reflections for the Week: How do I respond when life feels unjust or confusing? What small acts of faith might I begin, trusting God to grow them? Am I living in humility and service, without seeking applause? May we be strengthened by Scripture, emboldened by the Spirit, and remain steadfast in faith. God bless everyone always!!!

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas,

Las lecturas de hoy nos invitan a un diálogo honesto y lleno de esperanza acerca de la fe en tiempos de lucha. El profeta Habacuc expresa las preguntas de muchos: “¿Hasta cuándo, Señor?” —cuando la injusticia y el sufrimiento parecen no tener freno. La respuesta de Dios, aunque no inmediata, nos señala hacia una esperanza futura: “el justo vivirá por su fe.”



En el Evangelio, la súplica de los discípulos, “Auméntanos la fe,” es tan urgente y sincera hoy como lo fue hace dos mil años. Ellos habían visto a Jesús sanar a los enfermos, perdonar a los pecadores y desafiar a los líderes. Sabían que una vida de discipulado así exigiría un valor y una confianza más allá de sus propias fuerzas. Por eso pidieron más fe. La respuesta de Jesús puede sorprendernos. No les entrega un gran plan ni les promete un poder inmediato. Más bien, los señala hacia algo pequeño: la fe como un grano de mostaza. Una semilla parece pequeña e insignificante, pero en las manos de Dios lleva un potencial inmenso. Incluso el acto más pequeño de confianza —una oración pronunciada en un momento difícil, un perdón ofrecido cuando duele, una disposición a servir cuando se está cansado— puede convertirse en algo mucho más grande de lo que imaginamos. Lo que Dios puede hacer está más allá de nuestro control y medida.

Jesús también cuenta una parábola sobre siervos que simplemente cumplen con su deber sin esperar agradecimientos especiales. Aquí nos recuerda que la fe no se trata de prestigio ni de privilegios; se trata de un servicio humilde. La fe crece no con gestos dramáticos, sino con la fidelidad constante: rezar cada día, amar con paciencia, servir en silencio, perdonar de buen grado. Este Evangelio nos invita a repensar lo que entendemos por “gran fe.” La verdadera fe no es cuestión de cantidad, sino de entrega. Es la valentía de confiar incluso nuestros pequeños esfuerzos al poder de Dios, y la humildad de servir sin buscar reconocimiento. Al pasar esta semana, recordemos: una fe pequeña, vivida con sinceridad, puede mover montañas—porque Dios es quien la hace crecer y quien obra maravillas.

Las palabras de san Pablo a Timoteo nos fortalecen: los dones que Dios nos ha dado no deben esconderse, sino avivarse, vividos con valentía, integridad y perseverancia. En nuestra vida diaria, estamos llamados a vivir con fidelidad, confiando en que Dios está obrando, aun cuando no lo veamos plenamente.

Reflexiones clave para la semana: ¿Cómo respondo cuando la vida parece injusta o confusa? ¿Qué pequeños actos de fe podría comenzar, confiando en que Dios los hará crecer? ¿Estoy viviendo en humildad y servicio, sin buscar aplausos? Que seamos fortalecidos por la Escritura, animados por el Espíritu, y que permanezcamos firmes en la fe. ¡¡Dios bendiga a todos siempre!!!

“¡Auméntanos la fe!”

En el Evangelio de este domingo, los apóstoles hacen una súplica muy humana y muy profunda: **“Señor, auméntanos la fe.”** Es una petición que nace de reconocer nuestra fragilidad y nuestra necesidad de Dios. Jesús responde con una imagen poderosa: “Si tuvieran fe del tamaño de un grano de mostaza...” indicando que no se trata de tener una fe grande, sino de tener una fe verdadera, activa y confiada, aunque sea pequeña.

La segunda parte del texto puede parecer exigente: Jesús habla del siervo que, después de trabajar todo el día, no espera recompensa especial por cumplir con su deber. Con esto, el Señor nos enseña que la fe auténtica se expresa en la humildad del servicio. No se trata de hacer cosas para “ganar puntos” con Dios, sino de vivir como discípulos fieles, que aman, sirven y obedecen por amor.

En un mundo que busca reconocimiento inmediato y recompensa constante, este Evangelio nos recuerda que la vida cristiana se construye en lo oculto, en lo cotidiano, en el servicio silencioso y generoso. Y que incluso lo poco que hacemos, si lo hacemos con fe, Dios lo convierte en gracia abundante.

Que también nosotros podamos decir cada día: “Señor, auméntanos la fe” y que esa fe nos impulse a servir con alegría y humildad.

"Seigneur, augmente en nous la foi"

L'évangile d'aujourd'hui nous invite à réfléchir sur ce qu'est la foi et à faire en sorte de la préserver et de la faire grandir.

Selon Jésus, la foi est une nouvelle manière de comprendre notre existence et notre monde, de vivre mieux les relations humaines, l'amour et le travail, le succès et l'échec, la maladie, la vie et la mort.

La foi c'est la force de Dieu qui nous accompagne et nous donne le courage de faire face à la vie et aux problèmes qui se présentent. Sans nous soustraire aux intempéries, elle nous aide à passer à travers la tempête.

Une belle image de cette foi chrétienne se retrouve dans la scène évangélique où Jésus saisit la main de Pierre qui commence à s'enfoncer dans les eaux du lac.

Grâce à la foi nous gardons le contact avec Dieu, notre compagnon de voyage, et nous savons que nous ne serons pas seuls à faire face aux difficultés. «Voici que je suis avec vous pour toujours, jusqu'à la fin du monde». (Mt, 28,20)

La foi est comme une boussole qui nous indique la direction à suivre avec la garantie que Dieu marche avec nous.

Cette direction que nous donne la foi et cette présence de Dieu à nos côtés nous procure la paix, la sérénité, l'espérance, la sécurité, malgré tout ce qui peut nous arriver.

La foi, c'est une façon de vivre, une attitude vis-à-vis la vie, une manière de comprendre ce qui se passe et qui nous permet de donner un sens à notre vie.

La foi est un don de Dieu. Mais ce don il faut le protéger, le faire grandir.

C'est ce que nous venons faire chaque dimanche au contact du Christ et au contact des autres membres de la communauté. La foi ne peut survivre si elle n'est pas alimentée.

Nous croyons peut-être que nous n'avons pas beaucoup de foi. Le Christ nous dit : commencez avec ce que vous avez. Ensuite, organisez-vous pour la faire grandir... par la prière, la méditation, l'engagement dans la paroisse ou dans des groupes de bénévoles. Donnez de votre temps et utilisez vos talents pour aider les autres... et vous verrez que votre foi grandira.

Cette foi que nous avons, nous devons aussi la transmettre aux autres, surtout aux enfants, aux petits enfants...

Dans la seconde lecture de ce dimanche, nous voyons Paul qui transmet à Timothée ce don précieux, et il invite Timothée à le transmettre à son tour...

La foi est un don précieux. Il nous faut la protéger, l'alimenter, la transmettre et faire en sorte qu'elle influence notre vie de tous les jours.

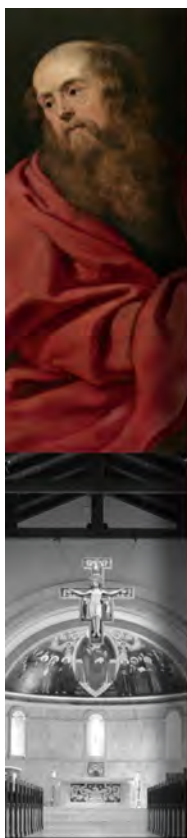

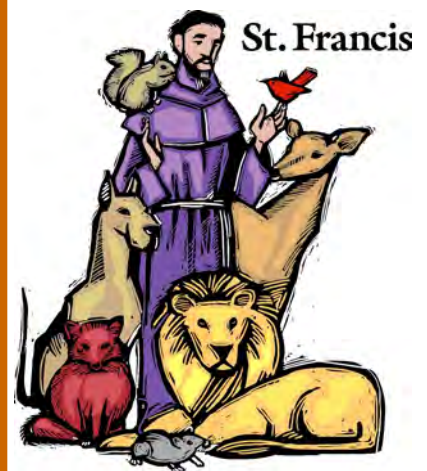

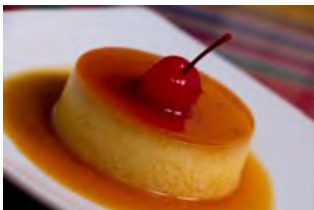
