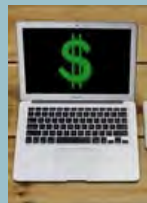

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

The Second Sunday in Ordinary Time marks a quiet but decisive turning point in the Church's liturgical year. Christmas has passed, the celebration of the Baptism of the Lord has concluded, and now we enter the steady rhythm of Ordinary Time. Yet today's readings remind us that what seems "ordinary" is filled with God's saving presence.

In the Gospel according to John (John 1:29–34), John the Baptist sees Jesus coming toward him and proclaims: "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world." These words, so familiar from the Mass, reveal the very heart of Jesus' mission. He is not introduced as a powerful ruler or a celebrated teacher, but as the Lamb—one who will give Himself completely for the life of the world. This image reaches deep into Israel's history: the Passover lamb whose blood brought freedom, and the suffering servant described by the prophet Isaiah. In today's first reading (Isaiah 49:3, 5–6), that servant is called not only to restore Israel, but to be "a light to the nations." God's saving plan is universal. From the very beginning, His mercy is meant for all peoples and all nations.

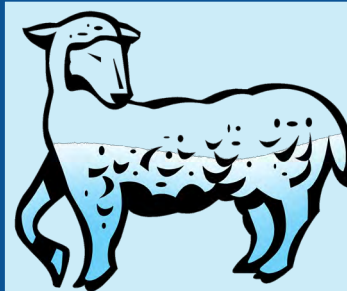
John the Baptist stands before us as a witness of humility and faith. He does not seek recognition for himself. Instead, he points away from himself and toward Christ. He testifies to what he has seen—the Spirit descending upon Jesus—and invites others to believe. His role is clear: to help the world recognize the presence of the Savior already among them.

St. Paul, in his greeting to the Corinthians (1 Corinthians 1:1–3), reminds the Church that all believers are "called to be holy." Holiness is not reserved for a few extraordinary individuals; it is the vocation of every baptized person. Ordinary Time is precisely where that holiness is shaped—in daily prayer, honest work, acts of charity, and faithfulness to God in the routines of life.

As we reflect on today's message, we do so under the loving gaze of Our Lady of Altagracia, Patroness of the Dominican Republic. As a mother, Mary was the first to behold the Lamb of God—not only with her eyes, but with her heart and her whole being. She carried Him, nurtured Him, and accompanied His mission with quiet faith and trust. Our Lady of Altagracia continues to point her children toward her Son, inviting us, like John the Baptist, to recognize Him and follow Him more deeply. May this Sunday renew our ability to behold Christ in our midst—especially in the Eucharist and in one another. Through the intercession of Our Lady of Altagracia, may we grow as believers who recognize the Lamb of God, trust in His saving love, and courageously witness to Him in our daily lives.

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas,

El Segundo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario marca un punto de transición silencioso pero decisivo en el año litúrgico de la Iglesia. La Navidad ha pasado, la celebración del Bautismo del Señor ha concluido, y ahora entramos en el ritmo constante del Tiempo Ordinario. Sin embargo, las lecturas de hoy nos recuerdan que lo que parece “ordinario” está lleno de la presencia salvadora de Dios.



En el Evangelio según san Juan (Juan 1,29–34), Juan el Bautista ve a Jesús que se acerca y proclama: «Este es el Cordero de Dios, que quita el pecado del mundo». Estas palabras, tan familiares para nosotros por la Misa, revelan el corazón mismo de la misión de Jesús. Él no es presentado como un gobernante poderoso ni como un maestro famoso, sino como el Cordero: aquel que se entregará completamente por la vida del mundo. Esta imagen se remonta profundamente a la historia de Israel: el cordero pascual cuya sangre trajo la libertad, y el siervo sufriente descrito por el profeta Isaías. En la primera lectura de hoy (Isaías 49,3.5–6), ese siervo es llamado no solo a restaurar a Israel, sino a ser «luz de las naciones». El plan salvador de Dios es universal. Desde el principio, su misericordia está destinada a todos los pueblos y a todas las naciones.

Juan el Bautista se presenta ante nosotros como un testigo de humildad y de fe. No busca reconocimiento para sí mismo. Al contrario, aparta la mirada de sí y la dirige hacia Cristo. Da testimonio de lo que ha visto —el Espíritu que desciende sobre Jesús— e invita a otros a creer. Su misión es clara: ayudar al mundo a reconocer la presencia del Salvador ya en medio de ellos.

San Pablo, en su saludo a los corintios (1 Corintios 1,1–3), recuerda a la Iglesia que todos los creyentes están «llamados a ser santos». La santidad no está reservada para unos pocos individuos extraordinarios; es la vocación de toda persona bautizada. El Tiempo Ordinario es precisamente donde esa santidad se va formando: en la oración diaria, el trabajo honesto, las obras de caridad y la fidelidad a Dios en las rutinas de la vida.

Al reflexionar sobre el mensaje de hoy, lo hacemos bajo la mirada amorosa de Nuestra Señora de la Altagracia, Patrona de la República Dominicana. Como madre, María fue la primera en contemplar al Cordero de Dios, no solo con sus ojos, sino con su corazón y con todo su ser. Ella lo llevó en su seno, lo cuidó y acompañó su misión con una fe silenciosa y confiada. Nuestra Señora de la Altagracia continúa señalando a sus hijos hacia su Hijo, invitándonos, como Juan el Bautista, a reconocerlo y a seguirlo más profundamente. Que este domingo renueve nuestra capacidad de contemplar a Cristo en medio de nosotros, especialmente en la Eucaristía y en nuestros hermanos y hermanas. Por la intercesión de Nuestra Señora de la Altagracia, que crezcamos como creyentes que reconocen al Cordero de Dios, confían en su amor salvador y dan testimonio de Él con valentía en la vida cotidiana.

¡Dios los bendiga siempre a todos!

Dans La première lecture, le prophète Isaïe nous rappelle que chacun de nous est **appelé par Dieu** et choisi dès le sein maternel. La mission du serviteur ne se limite pas à lui-même : Dieu veut faire de lui **une lumière pour les nations**, un signe de salut pour tous. Cela nous rappelle que notre foi n'est jamais seulement personnelle, elle est toujours tournée vers les autres.

Dans l'Évangile, Jean-Baptiste désigne Jésus en disant : « *Voici l'Agneau de Dieu* ». Il ne garde pas les regards pour lui-même, mais il **oriente les autres vers le Christ**. Jean reconnaît Jésus comme celui qui enlève le péché du monde et sur qui repose l'Esprit Saint.

Ces lectures nous posent une question simple mais profonde : **saurons-nous, comme Jean-Baptiste, montrer le Christ par notre vie ?**

Être chrétien, ce n'est pas seulement croire, c'est témoigner. Par nos paroles, nos choix et notre amour, nous sommes appelés à être, nous aussi, une lumière pour les autres.

Demandons au Seigneur la grâce de reconnaître Jésus chaque jour et de le faire connaître autour de nous.

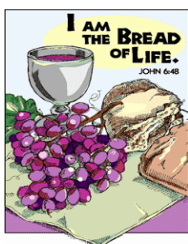
