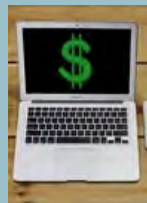

Message from the Our Pastor – Sixth Sunday Ordinary Time

Dear Sisters and Brothers, this Sunday's Gospel (Matthew 5:17–37) places us firmly within the Sermon on the Mount, where Jesus challenges his listeners—and us—to move beyond a minimal understanding of faith. "I have come not to abolish but to fulfill," he says, and then he proceeds to raise the bar. It is no longer enough simply to avoid murder; we must confront anger and resentment. It is no longer enough to avoid adultery; we must examine our desires, our intentions, and the fidelity of our hearts. At first glance, these words may feel heavy or even discouraging. Jesus' teaching seems demanding, uncompromising, and difficult to live. Yet when we listen carefully, we hear not a message of condemnation but a call to deeper love – love that is honest, faithful, and rooted in the heart.

That message resonates especially this weekend as we celebrate Valentine's Day. Our culture often associates love with romance, sentiment, or fleeting emotion. While those elements can be beautiful, Jesus invites us to something far more substantial. He speaks of a love that is faithful in action, respectful in thought, and sincere in intention. It is a love that does not settle for appearances but seeks integrity—where what we profess with our lips is reflected in how we live, speak, and treat one another. True love, as Jesus presents it, is demanding because it is transformative. It requires self-examination and conversion. It asks us to look honestly at our relationships: How do we speak to those closest to us? Do we harbor grudges, nurture bitterness, or dismiss others with careless words? Are we faithful—not only in marriage, but in friendship, family life, and community? On this Valentine's weekend, the Gospel reminds us that love is not just something we feel; it is something we choose and live out each day.

The first reading echoes this challenge. The Book of Sirach tells us that God sets before us fire and water, life and death, good and evil—and invites us to choose. Love, in the biblical sense, is always a choice. God respects our freedom, but also shows us the path that leads to life. Jesus does the same in the Gospel: he does not lower the standard, but he walks with us as we strive to live it.

This Sunday also serves as a quiet threshold. Ash Wednesday is just around the corner, marking the beginning of Lent. The timing is providential. Before we receive ashes and hear the call to repentance, Jesus asks us to look inward. Lent is not primarily about giving things up; it is about allowing God to reshape our hearts. The Gospel today names precisely the areas where that reshaping often needs to happen—our thoughts, our words, our relationships, and our integrity. As we prepare for Lent, this Sunday's readings invite us to consider what kind of conversion God may be asking of us this year. Is there a relationship in need of healing? An old resentment that needs to be surrendered? A habit of speech that wounds rather than builds up? Ash Wednesday will remind us of our mortality, but it also reminds us that change is possible, that grace is real, and that God's mercy is always within reach.

Valentine's Day, then, is not a distraction from the Gospel—it is a fitting lens through which to hear it. The love we celebrate, whether romantic, familial, or communal, finds its deepest meaning when rooted in Christ. His love goes beyond sentiment; it embraces sacrifice, forgiveness, and fidelity. It is a love that fulfills the law because it fulfills the human heart. May this week be a time to choose love more intentionally, to prepare our hearts for repentance, and to step into the season ahead with honesty, hope, and faith. God bless everyone always !!!

Queridos hermanos y hermanas, el Evangelio de este domingo (Mateo 5, 17–37) nos sitúa de lleno en el Sermón de la Montaña, donde Jesús desafía a sus oyentes —y a nosotros— a ir más allá de una comprensión mínima de la fe. «No he venido a abolir, sino a dar cumplimiento», dice, y a continuación eleva el listón. Ya no basta simplemente con evitar el homicidio; debemos confrontar la ira y el resentimiento. Ya no basta evitar el adulterio; debemos examinar nuestros deseos, nuestras intenciones y la fidelidad de nuestro corazón. A primera vista, estas palabras pueden parecer pesadas o incluso desalentadoras. La enseñanza de Jesús parece exigente, inflexible y difícil de vivir. Sin embargo, cuando escuchamos con atención, no oímos un mensaje de condena, sino una llamada a un amor más profundo: un amor honesto, fiel y arraigado en el corazón.

Este mensaje resuena de manera especial este fin de semana, al celebrar el Día de San Valentín. Nuestra cultura suele asociar el amor con el romance, el sentimiento o la emoción pasajera. Aunque esos elementos pueden ser hermosos, Jesús nos invita a algo mucho más sólido. Habla de un amor fiel en las acciones, respetuoso en el pensamiento y sincero en la intención. Es un amor que no se conforma con las apariencias, sino que busca la integridad, donde lo que profesamos con los labios se refleja en la manera en que vivimos, hablamos y tratamos a los demás. El verdadero amor, tal como lo presenta Jesús, es exigente porque es transformador. Requiere examen de conciencia y conversión. Nos pide mirar con honestidad nuestras relaciones: ¿Cómo hablamos con quienes están más cerca de nosotros? ¿Guardamos rencores, alimentamos la amargura o desestimamos a otros con palabras descuidadas? ¿Somos fieles —no solo en el matrimonio, sino también en la amistad, la vida familiar y la comunidad? En este fin de semana de San Valentín, el Evangelio nos recuerda que el amor no es solo algo que sentimos; es algo que elegimos y vivimos cada día.

La primera lectura hace eco de este desafío. El libro del Eclesiástico nos dice que Dios pone delante de nosotros fuego y agua, vida y muerte, bien y mal, y nos invita a elegir. El amor, en el sentido bíblico, es siempre una elección. Dios respeta nuestra libertad, pero también nos muestra el camino que conduce a la vida. Jesús hace lo mismo en el Evangelio: no rebaja la exigencia, sino que camina con nosotros mientras nos esforzamos por vivirla.

Este domingo también funciona como un umbral silencioso. El Miércoles de Ceniza está muy cerca y marca el comienzo de la Cuaresma. El momento es providencial. Antes de recibir las cenizas y escuchar el llamado a la conversión, Jesús nos pide mirar hacia dentro. La Cuaresma no se trata principalmente de renunciar a cosas; se trata de permitir que Dios transforme nuestro corazón. El Evangelio de hoy nombra precisamente las áreas donde esa transformación suele ser necesaria: nuestros pensamientos, nuestras palabras, nuestras relaciones y nuestra integridad. Al prepararnos para la Cuaresma, las lecturas de este domingo nos invitan a considerar qué tipo de conversión Dios puede estar pidiéndonos este año. ¿Hay alguna relación que necesita sanación? ¿Algún resentimiento antiguo que deba ser entregado? ¿Un hábito de hablar que hiere en lugar de edificar? El Miércoles de Ceniza nos recordará nuestra mortalidad, pero también nos recordará que el cambio es posible, que la gracia es real y que la misericordia de Dios está siempre al alcance.

El Día de San Valentín, entonces, no es una distracción del Evangelio; es un lente adecuado a través del cual escucharlo. El amor que celebramos, ya sea romántico, familiar o comunitario, encuentra su sentido más profundo cuando está arraigado en Cristo. Su amor va más allá del sentimiento; abraza el sacrificio, el perdón y la fidelidad. Es un amor que cumple la ley porque colma el corazón humano. Que esta semana sea un tiempo para elegir el amor con mayor intención, para preparar nuestros corazones a la conversión y para entrar en el tiempo que se aproxima con honestidad, esperanza y fe. ¡Que Dios bendiga a todos siempre!

Siracide 15,15-20

Matthieu 5,17-37

Les lectures d'aujourd'hui nous parlent de liberté, de loi et surtout du cœur.

Dans le livre du Siracide, Dieu nous dit clairement : « Si tu le veux, tu peux observer les commandements. » Dieu nous a créés libres. Il ne nous force pas à choisir le bien, mais il nous montre le chemin de la vie. Chaque jour, nous sommes placés devant un choix : la vie ou la mort, le bien ou le mal. Notre foi n'est donc pas une contrainte, mais une réponse libre à l'amour de Dieu.

Dans l'Évangile, Jésus va plus loin. Il ne supprime pas la Loi, mais il l'accomplit. Il nous montre que le véritable problème n'est pas seulement ce que nous faisons, mais ce que nous portons dans notre cœur. La colère, la rancune, le regard qui utilise l'autre, la parole qui blesse : tout cela peut déjà nous éloigner de Dieu, même sans geste extérieur.

Jésus nous invite à une justice plus profonde, une justice du cœur. Il nous appelle à aimer en vérité, à chercher la réconciliation, à respecter l'autre dans sa dignité. Ce n'est pas facile, mais c'est possible avec la grâce de Dieu.

En ce dimanche, demandons au Seigneur un cœur nouveau, capable de choisir le bien, non par peur, mais par amour. Que notre vie devienne un témoignage vivant de l'Évangile.
